

In the Name of God Amen, I Lem Woodhouse of the County of Currituck in the State of North Carolina being Very sick in body but of perfect sound Disposing mind & Memory Thanks be to god for the same Calling to mind that it is Appointed for all to die so make this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth, I Give and Bequeath my Soul to God that Giver of all things and my Body to be buried in the Christian manner at the Last day I shall be in, and his Everlasting Kingdom. No Trusting those Wickedly Good wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me with I Give and bequeath in the following Manner.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my sister Mary Gray one Negro Girl Named Din.

Item I Give & bequeath unto William Woodhouse Currier one Negro Girl Named China to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I Give to my Cousin Nathan Phil One Negro boy named Ned to him and his heirs, I also Give him all my Cloath.

Item I Give unto my Cousin Sarah Phil one Negro boy Named Will to him and his heirs.

Item I Give unto my friend Sam Jarvis Junr One Negro man Named Sam to him and his heirs Also one Mare.

Item I Give unto my Aunt Elizabeth Phil one Negro Woman Named Jane After her death my desire is that said John and Iveson shall to and to the property of my Cousin Nathan Phil and his heirs.

Item I Give unto my Nephew Thomas Taylor one Negro boy Named Solomon to him and his heirs.

I leave my Nephew Thomas Taylor & John Humphreys Esq. Executors of this my last will & Testament. Wholly Discharging all their Duty hereof I have executed at my hand & signed my said Will 19. day of April Anno Domini 1782.

I John Callis of the County of Currituck & State of N. Carolina being Very sick in body but of sound mind and Memory Thanks be to god, but knowing the Mortality of my body, I hereby make and execute this to be my last will and Testament. First of all I Give & bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me, & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of Executors hereafter mentioned. And as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this life I Dispose of them in the following Manner. Viz;

Item I Give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Sarah Callis all and Singular my goods & Chattels, Land and Tenements to have and her heirs forever (except the land and plantation whereon I now live which I Give and bequeath to the Child which my said wife may be with Child with to be the property of the same when it comes to age which I Give to that of its heirs forever, but in case the Child dies under age, the said land is to come in the hands of my beloved wife Sarah Callis which with all the remaining part of my Estate before mentioned I Give & bequeath to her and her heirs forever, I do likewise Appoint my well beloved wife Sarah Callis, Executors, & W. Francis Williamson Executor to this my last will & Testament ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament.

Sign, seal'd, Delivered, pronounced & Declared by the said John Callis to be his last will & Testament.
