I leave to be sold all my blacksmiths tools and some
quantity of iron and one te Stand and all my Books

I give all the rest of my property in darts & out doors &
to my wife during her Natural Life —
and I do hereby make and ordain my worthy Friend
Edw. Bunnell Executor to this my last will and Testament

my last and best mind set my abid Seal the day and

fly to her and her heirs forever and also a note of fifty pounds
due from Isler Cooper in Halifax to her and her heirs forever
and all the rest of my property except such legacies as shall
be hereafter mentioned the care of it and all of it within doors and
without during her Natural Life or Widowhood then to be equally
divided amongst four youngest daughters Julia Ann Mary Frances
and Barbrey and my two youngest sons Andrew and Arthur
Arthur C. Heath and if either of them die without heir of their
body lawfully begotten to be equally divided amongst the living
heirs of the six above mentioned Children to them and their
heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Margaret Bunt five Shillings to her
and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my two beloved Sons Pyland
Heath and Enoch Heath my Land and plantation where
I now live on to be divided as followeth beginning at the run
thence running along the ditch as fair as the ditch extends to
a strait course as fair as my land extends thence binding
on Daniel Sees line Pyland Heath to have the part next
to Daniel Sees the other to Enoch Heath to them and their
heirs forever and if either of my two Sons Pyland Heath
or his Brother Enoch Heath shall die without Lawfull
heirs of their bodies his part shall go to Andrew and his
heirs of his body Lawfully begotten and if either of the
three Eldest die without heir to go to Arthur Cooper
Heath and his heirs Lawfully begotten of his body

Item I do nominate and appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Heath Executrix
and Enoch Range to this my last will & Testament whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this the 25th day of January 1795
