my hand above seal that

Also after all my just debts are paid I give to my beloved son Thomas
White the whole of the residue of my Estate consisting of slaves cattle & all
household furniture &c &c to be under direction or disposal of my
executors hereafter named it is also my will and desire of my said
son Thomas White should die in his Minority or without heirs
as aforesaid then the whole of my Estate both personal & real
I give to my beloved wife Mary Ann Standley to her & her heirs for ever
I do hereby appoint my trusty friends my brother Edward Standley
& Edentown Lawyer Executors to this my last Will and Testament

Common furniture to her and her heirs for ever —
Leave to be sold all my blacksmith tools and some
quantity of iron and steel and my Mere and Cart and some
quantity of old Iron and one trestle stand and all my Books
one little

After all the rest of my property is done & out dores I
give to my wife during her Natural Life —
and I do hereby make and ordain my worthy Servants
Edw Burnell Executor to this my last will and testament
witness whereof the said John Capth have to thair
my last and testament set my abd Seal the day and
year above written John Capth Esq

God for the same do therefore make and Ordain this to be
my last Will and testament in manner & form as
followeth witness first I recommend my soul to the hands of
him that give it to me and my body I give to the Earth
from whence it was taken to be buried in a Christian like
manner by apid at the direction of my Executors hereafter
named as for my temporal Estate I dispose of as follows
Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Heath

One feather bed and furniture two Coats and Calfs one Maircal
fay to her and her heirs forever and also a note affy five pounds
due from Isle Cooper in halifax to her and her heirs forever
and all the rest of my property except such legacies as shall
be hereafter mentioned the sum of it and all fit wthondor and
without during her Natural Life or Widowhood then to be equally
divided among four youngett daughters Julianne franklyn
and Barbry and my two youngest sons Andrew also ~~and~~
Arthur & Heath and if either of them die without heir of their
body lawfully begotten to be equally divided amongst the living
heirs of the six above mentioned Children to them and their
heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Margaret Brant five shillings to her
and her heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath to my two belovd Sons Pylane
Heath and Enoch Heath my Land and plantation in a place
I now live on to be divided as folleth beginning at therein
there running along the ditch as fair as the ditch extends
a strait course as fair as my land extend three binding
on Daniel Lee his Pylane Heath to have the first part
to Daniel Lee the other to Enoch Heath to them and their
heirs forever and if either of my two Sons Pylane Heath
or his other son Enoch Heath shall die without Lawfull
heirs of thier bodies his part & part to Andrew and his
heirs of his body lawfully begotten and if either of the
three Eldest die without heir his part to Arthur Cooper
Heath and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body —
Item I do nominate and appoint my belovd wife Elizabeth Heath Executrix
and Enoch Cooper to their my last will & testament wherof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this the 25th day of January 1795
