Robinson of Warrap Banks in the County of Currituck & of the
State of North Carolina being very sick & weak in body but of a
perfect mind & memory God be praised, and knowing it is appointed
for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testa-
ment that is to say first of all, I recommend my body to the Earth
to be buried in a decent & Christian like manner at the discretion
of my Executors, and my soul into the hands of God that gave it. And
as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me
in this life, I give & dispose of the same in manner & form following
premises my desire is & well is that all my just debts & funeral charges
be lawfully paid by my Executors herein named. Francis Robinson my
brother & my son William Robinson whom I do name and constitute to
be Executors. Item, I give & bequeath unto my son William Robinson one
hundred & eighty Acres Land on Warrap Banks Joining the southmost
line of Robert Burrows Land. Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter
Sara fifty Acres of Land being the remainder of the pattern mentioned
in I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Sara Robinson the plantation
whereon I live containing one hundred & fifty Acres & after her de-
cease to my son Christopher Robinson. Item I give & bequeath
unto my loving wife Sara Robinson all my moveables during
her life & after her decease to my son Christopher Robinson. And
as for these presents, I make & disannul & disallow all other wills
& Testaments and bequests by word or writing herebefore made or named by
me & do hereby ratify & confirm all & every thing hereinbefore said & do hereby
