Wishes & other abstraitinances unto my two Sons Samuel & William & Heringe
these three Children to be equally divided between them, —

and not before, — Then I give Miquath unto my beloved wife Mary all the residue of my Estate goods & Chattels of what nature soever they may be taken in regard by the said Henry & soever, Then I give Miquath unto my said wife Mary the use of my Lands till opportunity is long, & she shall continue a widow, — Then I give Miquath unto my said wife Mary the use of the Cross & Nature the Bed & the Cross & the Chamber together with my sons while my sons shall respectively attain the age of Eighteen years provided she shall deliver to my sons on their attaining that age the several articles well considered and good in their minds.

It is my intention that my two sons shall live with the subject & dependent
 my said Mole Mary until they shall respectively attain the age of Eighteen
 to which said Mole Mary shall be permitted then with due provision for their
 clothing &c my said sons shall not otherwise be liable to live with or pay my said Mole Mary
 shall be at free from any obligation to maintain them. — Now for my Wife that in any
 case whatsoever my said Mole shall advance expense and my said sons in school during
 the space of Eighteen Months each, at the seasons most advantageous to them, before they shall
 have accomplished the years of Eighteen. — Now it is my Will that if my said Mole Mary
 Mole Mary a Mole whose daughter is to her Mother Jane Lee, Mole Mary shall have
 the said Jane Lee for so long as she shall continue unmarried two Acres of Land degen-
 ing as a Corn Field or the like situate between Richard Blounts Lane & Moore Moore running
 on said Lane is complete & a Square of 100 Acres further I constitute & appoint my
 Father Amos, Charles & my Mole Mary their Joint Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills & Testaments this only to be taken as my last
 Will & Testament, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Twelfth
 day of Apr in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred Eighty eight
 and sealed & subscribed to be the Testators last
 Will & Testament in presence of us }

With these ingredients into my beloved wife the use of all my talents & possessions & no less than the sacrifice of having London get that is to say slaves in West India at as low an able price pay of my detestable & odious spirit of sweetening that is to say sugar and my wife of sweetening the more as long as there remains a man or his natural life.
