Item, I Give the Use of my Lands to my beloved
 Wife Mary Hughes during her Natural Life like-
 wise all my Parishable Estate After her Decease
 I Give all my Lands that I have in Possession at
 that time to my Grandson James Hughes Senior
 all my Parishable Estate to him and his Heir
 forever but it is my Will and Desire that the
 Parishable Part of the Estate should be sold for
 Twelve Months Credit the Money to be Collected
 and put out upon Interest for the use of my Grand-
 son James Hughes as the Law Directs

Item, I do Constitute and Appoint my beloved
 Wife Mary Hughes and James Phillips and
 Zebulon Williams His and sole Executors of this
 my Last Will and Testament Revoking and
 Disannulling all other Wills as Well as
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal

In the year of our Lords 1772 The 20th Day of July
 John Woodhouse of the County of Guilford New England
 of Body but of a Perfect mind & Memory Thanks be to God for
 the same thus far calling to mind that it is appointed for
 all men once to die do make and Ordain this my Last Will and
 Testament in Maner & forme as followeth
 I Give & Recommend my Soul
 to the Hands of almighty Gods that Just Ruler and nothing
 doubting but trusting in the merits of my Redeemer Jesus
 Christ to make followe for ever & ever to save to the utmost all
 that Come unto God by Him. As to my Body I Recommend it to
 the Earth from whence it was taken to be Buried in Christianlike
 manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Named
 Nothing doubting but to be buried by the mighty Power of Gods
 and Fathering such Worldly Goods & Estates with which I am
 blessed almighty Gods to bless me with Blessings bequeath
 in the manner and form following

Item I Give & bequeath to my son John Woodhouse my
 Plantation & Land Belonging thereto that I do Belong to the
 Land of Wm. Jargan and William White known by the Name of
 Churchman Island with him & the Heirs of his Body Lawfully
 Begotten forever. I also Give unto my son John one Negro Male
 Named Hannah & conveying Negroes filled named Sam^l & three
 Negroes. I Give unto my son John one Negro Male named
 Charles & one Negro Boy named Charles one Negro Male named
 Benjamin and one Negro Boy named Rufus. I also Give unto my
 son John all my stock of Cattle that is at or belongs unto the
 Plantation that I have & have Given him. I also Give unto my
 Cattle taken from the stock of Cattle that belongs to the Plan-
 tation where I now live. I also Give unto my son John
 James the Woodhouse & to the Heirs of their Body Lawfully Begotten
 forever my Land and Marsh Belonging thereto, known by the
 Name of Bay new Island to be Equally Divided between them
 and the Heirs of their Body Lawfully Begotten as aforesaid.
 I also Give unto my son John Woodhouse one Whoregony Cow of
 Drawing & one Whoregony Desk known by being Common by
 Cattle my own & the Heirs of their Body Lawfully Begotten
 forever. I also Give unto my son John Woodhouse thirty Three Half pence
 silver & two hundred Dollars. my Will & Desire is that my
 Negro fellow Joney should be sold by my Executors hereafter
 Named and the Money arising from his Sale to be Equally
 Divided between my two sons John & Samuel Woodhouse I
 also Give unto my son John one Silver turnstile
 Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Woodhouse
 my Land and Plantation whereon I now live to him
 & the Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten forever.
 I also Give unto my son Samuel Woodhouse one Negro
 Male named Anne and two Negro Girls named Jane
 & Charity & their Increase also two Negroes Boys named
 Ned & Will also one Negro fellow named Sam^l & one Negro
 Boy named Daniel. I also Give unto my son Samuel all my
 stock of Cattle at Poppon. I stand excepted from Cows and Calves
 and all my stock of Cattle that belongs to the Plantation
 whereon I now live except eight Head that I have Given
 out of them to my son John. I also Give unto my son
 Samuel Woodhouse all my Land that lies on the
 Banks and my will & Desire is that any Cattle
 that runs the said Land at the Banks should all except
 two Cows and Calves be sold by my Executors and the
 Money arising from the Sale to be Equally Divided
 between my three Children John & Sam^l Woodhouse
 and Mary Saunderson,
