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I Give and bequeath to my Dear & beloved son Bayella Jones all my land that I am possessed with if in case he wants Money to buy more land or to buy a Daughter and if the said Bayella Jones is Marry I bestow of these above named Daughters I Give the said Land to my son John Jones also one Slave also one Negro also one Horse Named Shubing I Give and bequeath to my Dear & beloved son Hazen Jones the said King of Battle also five Acres of Battle also one Slave Named Trudy also one Cow & Perennation also one Old Horse and bequeath unto my Dear & beloved son John Jones one Colt named Mount also one Cow and Perennation also five Acres of Battle I Give and bequeath to my Dear & beloved Wife Sarah Jones all the Estate that was hers before she was Married except the Negro Wintch Chain and what is made away with also five Acres of Shopp I Give and bequeath unto my son Bayella Jones three Acres of Battle also one Old Saddle Horse and bequeath unto my Wife Sarah Jones two Sows and broken Pigs also her large Manors I Give and bequeath unto my son John Jones all the Rest of my Negroes I Give and bequeath to my Wife Sarah Jones one Negro Wintch named Chain During her Life and Wintch that if in case she don't remove him and after her Death so he don't look to my son Bayella Jones Looking her two first Children in the future to be his three Acres of Battle and the Rest to his brother John Jones and my Will and desire is that the Reminders of my White Estate should be divided equally divided amongst my three Children viz Bayella and Hazen and John Jones and Bayella and John to the other two I shall pay all my Debts Each one Paying an Equal Part out of their Several Legacies and I do Appoint my Wife Sarah Jones and my son Bayella Jones to be my true and Lawfull Executors Discharging all my Will what so ever and I do declare this my last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have here unto set my Hand & Seal the Day of December
