Horse Called Sally me one and half one best & Furniture four Head
of Sheep me Peck and Son in Gunnison Isa Ketle and all my Pigs
and Chians. And I give and bequeath unto my Daugther Francis Cox
Two Head of cattle that is in her mather's Stock my Will and desire
that if the said Negroe Wench should not have one of my Children
a negroe Child at my Wifes Death I give one Negroe boy Maxent to
my Daughter Francis Cox also my Will and Desire is that if my
Death or Intermarrying that the said Wench Febe and Negroe
Boy I mean should be equally Divided between my two Daugthers
Mary Cox and Francis Cox Also I leave my Cattle that I have
not already given away and one young Horse as
