 I Give my Lands and Tenement to my Wife during of her widow-
 hood and then to be Equally Divided East and West betwixt my
 two Sons William Bonney and Gideon Bonney to them
 their heirs forever if each or other of them should die
 with thought a Careful heir of their body the Gift of my
 Land to my son Jonathan Bonney to him and his heirs forever.
 I bequeath to my Negroes (namely Leah & Lucy & Mary)
 Give and bequeath to my son Jonathan Bonney and my Daughter
 Demie Bonney to them and their heirs forever to be equally Divided
 when each of them come to age of Maturity.
 I Give to my Dear Wife the Corn that are Growing on the Ground
 together with all my hoggs and the residue of my Estate I leave
 to be Equally Divided betwixt my Wife and four Children.
 I bequeath to my Wife and Ordain my Wife and
 Ansell Jun: the Sole Executors of this my Last Will and
 Testament, and I do hereby utterly disavow and
 disannul all and Every Other former Testaments Wills Legacies
 Bequests and Executor by me in any way before Married Wills
 and bequeath the said my (Wife) and my four Children to be
 my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal this thirteenth Day of August the thousand
 seven hundred and Ninety two.
