Present Mr. Joseph Justice

The following will was then & proved in due form of Law, and on motion made
to be registered which according follows in these words. To wit

In the Name of God. Amos Furst I commit my body to the Earth
To be buried in a decent manner and secondly I Recommend my
Soul to God

Item after all my lawfull debts is paid. I leave the Remembrance
of all the debts that is due to me unto Solomon. And likewise one
bead and Furniture one Christ one Case and bedels one Gun
and all my Tools and one gold ring one. Silk handkerchief
one pair of Silver buttons one trunk two chest dear Mine
one Fidel and likewise all my lands that I have in North
Carolina after my debts to him and his Heirs for ever
December 4. 1 day 1761
