

314 In the name of God amen. I Jonathan Taylor being sick and weak of body  
But of sound and disposing mind and memory and willing to shun the uncertainty  
of human life, and that it is appointed for all men Once to die. do make and ordain  
This my last will and Testament in manner and form following.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Zephaniah Taylor the south end  
of my land cut over <sup>he</sup> now lives, begining at Lemuel Sandersons line thence  
Northwardly along the main road to a red oak standing near the Northwest  
corner of Nathaniel Brooks fence, thence westwardly to a pine standing at  
the edge of the flatley swamp thence a straight course to a pine at the north end  
of the Shingle ridge at the George Swamp thence along the Swamp side to  
Sandersons line thence to the first station, and at his desire to his son Joseph  
Taylor and his heirs. also fifty acres of marsh at the head of the bay to my son  
Zephaniah Taylor and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Benjamin Taylor all the land I have on  
Mastin Island to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Willoughby Taylor all the land I have  
In the Backwood between Peabody Taylor and Thomas Taylor, running westward  
Item I give and bequeath to my Son Marcy Taylor part of my land on  
The east side of the begining at a path leading from Long Point out at  
John Taylors line running westwardly along John Taylor line to a Pinemore  
Tree, standing in the lane on the east side of a pine thence eastwardly to a  
Poppinmon Tree, standing in the lane at Amos Grapeline thence eastwardly to  
John Taylors line thence along John Taylor line to the first station also an  
Acre of land at the north end of my land on the east side of the road leading  
Joseph Simmon begining at a pine my Cherry Tree, running southwardly to a  
Pine Stump thence eastwardly to a pine on the main Swamp line thence  
Northwardly to my line thence eastwardly to the first station, and if he  
Die without heir lawfully begotten of his body to fail to my Son Jonathan  
Taylor and his heirs. also my part of the inheritance left by my son Joseph  
Taylor and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Bridget Taylor two acres of land  
at the north end of my orchard, begining at the road running westwardly to a red oak  
at a pine thence northwardly thence eastwardly to the road. thence to the first station  
during her single life, and at her death on marriage to Jonathan Taylor and  
his heirs forever.

315 Item I give and bequeath to my Son Jonathan Taylor the land with  
Plantation cut over since his building our Jonathan Taylor line and  
Marcy Taylor line and one acre in the main Swamp or the other gift of  
one acre of marsh at the head of the bay and if he die without heir  
lawfully begotten of his body to fail to my Son Marcy Taylor and his heirs  
Also one desk and feather bed and furniture the usual and common  
large looking glass, one hundred nine and fifty dollars Paid to him his heirs forever  
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Bridget Taylor one negro  
named Obadiah feather bed and furniture one horse and Chaise carriage  
Humberilla one coachman Paid all my hoggs, hird, scutney and fifty dollars  
Each to buy and bury him forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Bridget Taylor one negro  
named Pegg two feather beds and furniture one new side saddle  
One Black evaluate desk, one starch <sup>box</sup> and fifty dollars in Paid to her  
and bury him forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my five Sons aforesaid all my effects  
And jewelry Swamp to be equally divided between them & their heirs forever  
All the remainder of my estate within reason and without I leave to be  
Equally divided between all my Children and their heirs except my  
Shooting gun I give to my grand son Jose Taylor furthermore I desire that  
My daughter Bridget Taylor shall live and stay with my Son Jonathan  
Taylor and take care of his property till he comes to age if she continues a  
Single woman. Lastly I hereby constitute appoint and ordain my two  
Son Willoughby Taylor and Marcy Taylor executors to this my last  
Will and Testament revoking all other wills or wills heretofore made  
Witness and Confirming this to be my last will and Testament. In witness  
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of December  
1809 A.D.
