 In the name of God Amen I Ruben Etheridge
 of the state of North Carolina and County of
 New Hanover being weak of Body but in perfect
 mind & memory calling to mind the uncertainty
 of life am a the certainty of death to make this
 my last will and Testament in manner
 and form following first I give my soul
 to the hand of the almighty God who gave me
 nothing doubting but it will be received at the
 last and my body to be buried at the discretion
 of my executors first that all my debts be paid
 I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Etheridge my
 beloved wife all my land and all my household
 property both real & chattel to her and her children
 user so long as she shall continue to long as
 she shall remain my widow and that if
 she shall marry again that the property shall
 be equally divided among them her children
 and her self and that my wife shall be my
 executor and this will shall supersede all other
 what so ever in writing whereof I have herunto set
 my hand and seal this the twenty eighth day of
 March in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty signed sealed
 in presence of us

The Last will and Testament of Joseph
 Daniel Dec^r was exhibited in open Court at
 New Hanover County Term 1821.

In the name of God Amen I Joseph Daniels
 of the State of North Carolina and County of
 New Hanover being of weak Body & failing to God
 perfect mind and memory and calling to
 mind that it is appointed for all men to die
 therefore doz no murmur and approach thy
 My last will and Testament to dispose of
 My worldly property where with the Lord has left
 me as follows Therefore recommend my soul in the
 hands of God that gave it and my body to be
 buried after a Christian like manner at the discretion
 of my executors and first of all after all my just
 debts being paid I give to my son David
 Daniel fifty Dollars to be placed out of my
 Estate to him and his heirs forever likewise
 I give to my son James Daniel the piece of land
 wherein he now lives with all the improvements
 thereon beginning at a black pine to the south
 end & extending of his house in the edge of
 the Lee and YB creek Daniel corner line running
 thence Northward from said line to the said
 Benjamin Daniels north East corner pine tree
 thence eastward so as to form nearly a square
 with the great swamp for about one hundred
 yards through the Branch that is to the eastward
 of the said Daniels Eastward fence then
 about the same distance from the branch
 Southward to the great swamp thence
 Westward with the edge of the swamp to the
 first Station to him and his heirs forever
 Likewise I give to my two sons Thomas and
 Avery Daniel my manor plantation wherein
 I now live with wood land and the improve-
 ments there unto beginning at a state in the
 corner of Frederick Daniels place there running
 with the dividing fence between Spencer Daniels
 and myself westward to a state in the river
 thence westward through the marshland
 swamps to a large shoot left pine tree
 in the edge of the north side of the great

say am per me the woodsy to the westwardly of
the first branch thence a direct course
through the great woodsy to my corner pyne
tree stand the head of the far branch there
eastwardly with the line of my Deed to a
large Cherry tree near the gate between my
house and Anchey Daniels then as with the
line fence to the full station all the remainder
of my upland on Roanoke Islands Chincys
Swamps including I give to be equally divided
between my three Daughters Elizabeth Austin
Darcie Pugh and Anney Daniel to them and
their Heirs for ever all my marsh on Roanoke
Islands and all my land property on Bodie
Islands. I give for a privilege equally amongst
the whole of my six before mentioned Children
sons and Daughters to them and their heirs forever
like wife all my boats and Canoe I give equally
amongst one of my three sons blacksmith tools &
Shop to James Thomas and a heavy Daniel
to them and their heirs for ever likewise and
singular the remaining of my property I give
equally amongst the whole of my Children before
mentioned Elizabeth Austin Darcie Pugh James
Thomas Avery & Anney Daniels to them and
their Heirs forever

I give to Avery Daniel one large Blue flowers
Chest. I give to Anney Daniels one Bed Bedstead
and furniture that is to say 1 Bolster 2 Pillows
2 Shirts 3 Blankets and one Rugg. - To Avery
Furnish all the Cabis Lass the mulin on land
etc to Anney Daniel on ne Young Horse
running on Bodie Island - like wise I give to
my daughter Elizabeth Austin one Bed and
furniture - to my Daughter Darcie Pugh one
Bed and furniture on Bodie Islands the before mentioned
articles to them and their heirs for ever
Likewise and singular the remaining part of my
property not to be for given I give to my six
children

this the thirteenth day of October in the Year of our
Lord eighteen hundred and twenty
