Almighty God for it Calling to mind the uncertainty
of this Life I Ordain this to be my last Will & Testament
in manner & form following.

First I Give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary Jones
all my hol Estate within Door & without Now her
Widowhood or Natural Life and then to Embury
Whaley the son of John Whaley to him & his Heirs
Ever.

Second I do Appoint my well beloved Wife Mary Jones with my
Trusty friend Benjamin Dargy to be my whole sole
Executor of this my Last Will and Testament in Witness
Whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & a signed
Seal this the third Day of October one thousand seven
Hundred & Seventy.
