

on Monday 17th May 1772, Joseph Bernard being my sick and weak
Cunited County but sound in mind and memory thanks be to God for it

As it is appointed once for all men to die, I do make known this to be my
last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows Viz

I Give the use of my Land and plantation where I now live to my beloved wife
Angelica Bernard during her natural life after her death I give the above
Mentioned Land to my daughter Huldah Bernard to her and her heirs
I Give to my beloved wife my Negro Samson during her Widowhood &
I give the said Negro to my daughter Huldah Bernard, And if she dies without
heir, then the said Negro to return to my beloved wife

I Give to my beloved wife my black mare as her own property forever, And my young
bay horse which I bought of Widow Robertson forever

I Give to my Daughter Huldah Bernard One three year old mare I bought of Ann Phillips
And one young Colt one of my black mare, foaled this spring, One Cow and year-
old at John Smiths, And two Cows of Calves & two two year old heifers at the
Indian Trade, And one feather bed and furniture, all the rest of my Estate within
doors & without I Give to my beloved wife as her own right for ever

My Will and desire is that my daughter Huldah Bernard all that I have given her
in and remain in the care of my two Executors which I appoint my beloved
Wife and William Bray my Whole and sole Executors of this my last Will
and Testament
