Mind and Memory Blessed be God, Do this 9th Day of December
in the Year of our Lord 1790, do make and Publish this my last
Will and Testament in Manner and Form following that is
to wit I Give & Leave this use of one hundred Pound, Note due from
Henry Evans one hand Mill 2 large Stone Sledge to my Wife Mary
Gray to my Son William Gray is twenty one years of age then I
Give the same property to my Son William to him and his heirs
forever. Also I Give the use of one high bedded and deep and
firmness to my Son John Pot, 1 large Pot, 1 Dish, 1 basin, 3 plates
to my Wife to my Daughter Rebecca her is Eighteen years of
age they to return to my Daughter Rebecca Gray to her and her
heirs forever. Also I Give the use of one low bed and deep and
firmness 1 large Iron Pot 1 small Pot, 1 Dish, 1 basin
3 plates to my Wife to my Daughter Frances is Eighteen
years of age. then I Give the property to return to my Daughter
Frances Gray to her and her heirs forever; but then if either of
my three Children that is now Named should die
without lawful heir for their parts to be divided between the
other two, or one that is living; then I leave all the remainder
of my Estate to my Wife Nancy Gray During of his life
then after his death to be divided between my said Children
to my Son and their heirs forever; Also I Give my hand and Seal
my Wife Nancy Gray Executor of this my last Will and Testament
in Witness my hand and Seal the Day and Year above Written
Signed sealed Published and Delivered in the presence of us who
then Present at the time of Signing and Sealing thereof

William Williams of Cumberland County State of N. Carolina
being of a sound disposing mind & memory Do hereby be to the able
God & Saviour of the World for the sake Do make and Ordain this my
last Will and Testament, in Manner and form following.

I Impromise I Give to my Wife Mary Williams two Negroes and
half of the plantation & House upon which I
should be inclined to spend the Remainder of her days thereon and
also Give my Wife one Horse & my riding Chair & ten hard Dollars and
all the Estate that may descend from her father to us, and request my
Children for my sake to use her with that tenderness her amiable good
nature and tenderness to me & them Calls for.

I Give to my Son John Stephen Williams the Lands hereafter
Given to my Son John Williams, Hollowell Williams and the Widow
Williams (excepted) that Plantation know lie on & lands adjacent one
Negro Man Joseph then I Give my cattle & Sheep to him & his heirs
forever.

I Give to my Son William Williams the Lands and Plantation
called Linards, Joining Caves & to him and his heirs forever.

I Give to my Son John Williams the Bridge Land as follows
beginning at the foot of bathend of the Bridge running down the Creek so
farth small cut thence up the Gut to a hole above obediash Capt
formerly lived Round North side of the Hole to a branch that runs
up between said Hole and where John Capt formerly lived to the
Main Road, thence South one Quarter of a Mile thence west to
the Creek, so down the Creek by various courses to the first station
to him and his heirs forever.

I Give to my Son Hollowell Williams the following Lands
beginning at the old new Ground Bathon Storrain Road near
Myrtle house, thence a straight course to a ditch in the back of
the field joining Edw Bunick, down the ditch to new ground
square, thence a straight course to a marked Gum line between
Daniel Thomas Oliver Jony Sands, thence a straight course
to a Oak standing in Bunick's field thence dividing line
between my Land and Bunick's to Line between my Land
& John Mays, thence down that line to Court House Road
at Robinsons Corner, thence up the Court House Road as it
formerly runs to the first station. to him & his heirs
forever.

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I Give to my Son Thos Swann only his Will &
two acres of Land were the Lands of Negro Robert, to him and his
Heirs for ever -
I Give the Use of fifty acres of Land I bought of Josiah
Ward to my five Sons, to them & their Heirs forever -
I Give to my Daughter Mary Harbent Two Negroes viz
Demmy and Doll, one Mary one bed & Furniture, which she now
hath in Copeston to her & her Heirs for ever -
I Give to my Daughter Sally Williams Two Negroes viz
Sagant & Mendel, a new Horse & one bed & Furniture to her & her Heirs
forever -
I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Williams Two Negroes viz
Elisha & Lucia one Horse & one bed & Furniture to her and her Heirs
forever -
The residue of my Estate Negroes &c I Give to be equally Divided
between my four Sons William Williams Tully Williams
Callowell Williams and Thomas Swann Williams, to them & their
Heirs forever -
I Give to my Sister (if she will except of him) Negro
Man Thomas

In the Name of God I Elisha Jenkins of the County of Currituck
and State of North Carolina being weak in Body but of perfect mind and
memory We see be God for the same and do make and publish this my last
Will and Testament in Manner as follows that is to say
I Give and bequeath unto my Son Simon Jenkins the Land and
Plantation whereon I now live to him and his heirs forever I also give
Simon Jenkins my horse Colt and best Gun with all my best and
best feather bed and furniture and hand Mill three best Chairs the best
Chest and all my tools to him and his heirs forever
I Give and bequeath unto my son Eschiel Jenkins the Land and
Plantation that I had of Thomas that William Mares now live
on to him and his heirs forever and my mare Colt large Chest and
table three Chairs one feather bed and furniture
I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Peggy all the Movable prop-
erty she has now in her possession with or without to her and her
heirs forever
I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Betsy Jenkins one bed
and furniture two Kitties one white pig Cow to her and her heirs forever
I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Dinah Jenkins one cow
one pig and Kittle with all her Mothers Cloats to her and her heirs forever
I Give unto my Daughter Mary Jenkins one Spinning Wheel
I Give my Estate to be Equally divided between Simon Eschiel
and Dinah Jenkins the rest of my Estate I leave to be sold to defray
Lawful Charges and the benefit of my small Children and leave
my trusty friend John Capts my sole and sole Executor to this
my last Will and Testament utterly denying and revoking all other
will or wills Owning Confirming and Establishing this my
last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and fixed my seal this twenty sixth day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety
four
