I Item I have to my beloved wife Abigail my Plantation and Land belonging to it during her Natural life and Widewhood.

I Item and at the Death of my wife or Marriage Give and bequeath the aforesaid Plantation and tract of Land to my son Thomas Ives to him and his heirs as also one Slave Call'd Tom Red heifer one Young Cow and also one bed and furniture to be Delivered to him when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty Years

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Euphan one bed and Furniture to be Delivered to her when she shall arrive to the age of Sixteen years.

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughters Lucy Bolt my Coat of hand against Zechariah Dugd and also one Coat of hand against John Bost, and also one Coat of Hand against Thomas Cornish and also one Brindled Seter and also two Cows of a Brindled and white color to her and her heirs.

Item I leave to my beloved Wife Abigail all the remainder Part of my Movable estate that am by her Given Birth without mans without her during her life or Widewhood, and at her Death to my Daughters up to her and their heirs lawfully begotten of Bolt. And also I Constitute and Appoint my beloved wife to be my whole and Sole Executor to bury my Body in Christian like manner and to settle my Estate as aforesaidmention'd Denying all other Wills by me formerly made and acknowledge them to be my last will and Testament as written above.

I Joshua White poor Slave and orfain this my last Will and Testament - I Will that my wife Lydia During her Widewhood to have and to hold the Plantation or Farm I now reside upon with two Work horses, one Cart & the Plow harrows belonging to the said Farm two Leather Boxes & Furniture, one Negro Wentz h Named Rose I bequeath my wife During her Widewhood or Life, afterwards she and her increase to be Divided between four of my Little Children Namely Henry, Lazarus, Prudencio & Ann. I give to my wife all my Iron Work have Access to it. Also I Give her Two with Lamb & Two Cows with their Calves two Sheep all my Stock of Hoggs, all my Corn, & Meet that is laid in my house for Provision, Two linen Wheels, one Wollen one, one Doom and all her Taklin I Give to my Daughter Lucy one little Negroe Girl Named Lucy, one Leather Box & Furniture, one Wollen Wheel, & one Linen Wheel.

I Give unto my Son Joshua the Plantation I now live on to him and his Lawfull heirs, if he should die without Lawful issue to return to my wife Henry. I give to my Son Patrick one Piece of Land lying on Mattamacket on the lake, Also the Stock that is without him and his Lawfully begotten Heirs & in Case he should die without Lawfull heir, to return to my wife Henry. I Give to my Son Henry, Thedo Olds Bond with all the Interest & Devons it, all the remainder of my Sheep and Cattle I Give to be Equally Divided among my Children. And all the remainder Part of my Household Furniture not above Mention'd, to be Equally Divided among my wife and Children.
