I Josiah Dowdy son of the State of North Carolina and County  
of Currituck being sick and weak in body but of sound  
mind and memory thanks be to god for the same calling  
to mind the mortallity of my body and knowing that it is  
appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my  
last will and Testaments in manner and form following  
I promise, my will and desire that after my decease all my  
just debts be paid out of my Estate by my executors hereafter  
Item I Lend The use of all the rest and residue of my Estate  
Land moveable Estate unto my wife Rebekah Dowdy during her natural life  
Item I Give unto my daughter Nancy Dowdy six dollars to be  
raised out my lands to her and her heirs.

Item I give unto my daughter Sally Anderson six dollars to be raised  
out of my lands to her and her heirs.

Item I gave unto my daughter Peggy Dowdy six dollars to be  
raised out of my lands to her & her heirs.

Item I give unto my daughter Betty Dowdy six dollars to be  
to be raised out of my lands to her and her heirs.

Item I give unto my daughter Patsey White six dollars to be  
raised out of my lands to her and her heirs.

Item I give unto my daughter Rebekah Dowdy six dollars  
to be raised out of my lands to her and her heirs.

Item After my wife Rebekah Dowdy decease and after the legacies  
above mentioned are paid to my daughters I give the remainder  
of my lands on the main to my son John Dowdy and his heirs.

Item my will and desire is that <sup>my</sup> Lands on the Banks be sold

Fifty acres in a lot at six months credit by my Executor

Item my will and desire is that <sup>after</sup> my wife decease all the rest  
or residue of my Estate if any. Be Equally Divided amongst all my  
children.

Lastly I appoint Thomas Poyner sen<sup>r</sup> my whole and sole Executor  
of this my last will and testament, given under my hand & seal  
this the 9th day of February 1828
