I Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Lydia Busley one feather
bed & furniture her Choice of all I have One common Wheel one working wheel
One Chair her Choice One Box and Casket her Choice out of all my Stock I am
Hence one soon & give one table and the half of all my hogs to her also
her hirs forever. I also leave the use of all my movable Property to her
During the time she continues to be my widow and all my lands and
Plantation until my son Samuel Busley arrives to the age of twenty one
years then for him to have it as devised to him

I Item I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Busley all the lands now
Bequeath to him and his heirs forever to be divided of two thirds of said
Lands when he arrives to the age of twenty one years and the other third
At his mothers death I also give to my son Samuel Busley one house mill
and one gun to be delivered him at the age of twenty one by my Executors
Item after the death or marriage of my wife Lydia Busley I leave all
my moveable Property that will bequeath to my son Samuel Busley to be
Equally divided amongst all my Children except Samuel Busley my
Dowry as he has no Part part of my moveable Property except such as
is mentioned in the gift to him except one horse bearing that I have given
him and will be distinguished by a mark peculiarly to himself and his
Increase I also make Constitute and appoint my brothers William
Busley and Henry Busley my whole and sole Executors to this my
Last will and testament revoking and revoking all others before
Made by me in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal
and seal my seal to be affixed this ninth day of March one thousand
Eight hundred and one

To be my last will and Testament in manner and form following

first I desire all my just debts to be paid by my Executors and for the
rest of my estate I dispose of in the following manner

I Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Josiah Simpson that
Land and Plantation that I first bought of John Grant Containing
of Seventy four acres of Land more or less Also One Negro Girl by the name
of Sibell Also four Head of Cattle Also two feather beds and furniture else
one more and All to him and his heirs forever.

I Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son William Simpson
Seventy three acres of Land more or less the last Name I bought of John Grant
Also one Negro boy by the Name of Lewis also four Head of Cattle also two feather
beds and furniture also one horse by the Name of Harry to him and his
heirs forever. And my will and desire is that my Negro woman Sarah
and her two youngest Children Should be sold to pay my debts and
all my estate that is not given away shall be equally divided between
my two sons Josiah and William Simpson to them and their heirs
forever. And my will and desire is that my Executors have full power
to administer and sell my Estate before they are qualified and I do
Nominate and appoint Nathan and Spence Hall Executors
to this my last will and testament in witness to the above instruments
Set my hand this 9th day of March 1801
