one Child her choice one Cow and calf her choice out of all my stock one
Horse one Corn & Giver one table and the half of all my hogs to her and
her heirs forever I also leave the use of all my moveable property to her
During the time she continues to be my widow and all my lands and
Plantation untill my son Samuel Busby arrives to the age of twenty one
years then for him to have it as devised to him

I Now Give and bequeath to my son Samuel Busby all the lands I own
except to him and his heirs forever to be possessed of two thirds of said
Lands when he arrives to the age of twenty one years and the other third
At his mothers death I also give to my son Samuel Busby one hand mill
and one gun to be delivered him at the age of twenty one by my Executors

I Now after the death or marriage of my wife Lydia Busby I leave all
my moveable property that not given to my son Samuel Busby to be
Equally divided amongst all my Children except Samuel Busby my
Will is he has the back part of my moveable property except such as
is mentioned in the gift to him except one silver Quilling that I've given
him and will be distinguished by a mark peculiarly to himself and his
Issue I also make constitute and appoint my brothers William
Busby and Henry Busby my whole and sole Executors to this my
Last will and testament Encompassing and Encompassing all others therefore
Made by me in witness whereof I have set my hand and added
and seal my seal to be affixd this Ninth day of March one thousand
Eight hundred and one

I Now Give and bequeath unto my beloved son Josiah Simpson the
Land and Plantation that I first bought of John Grant Containing
of twenty four Acres of Land more or less Also one Negro Girl by the Name
of Sibel Also four head of Cattle Also two feather beds and furniture also
one mare and calf to him and his heirs forever.

I Now Give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Simpson
Twenty Acres of Land More or less the last time I bought of John Grant
Also one Negro boy by the Name of Saver Also four head of Cattle also two feather
beds and furniture also one horse by the Name of Pracey to him and his
heirs forever. And my will and desire is that my Negro woman Sarah
and her two young children should be sold to pay my debts and
all my estate that is not given away shall be equally divided between
My two sons Josiah and William Simpson to them and their heirs
forever. and my will and desire is that my Executors have full power
to advertise and sell my Estate before they are qualified And I do
Nominate and appoint Nathan and Spencer Hall Executors
to this my last will and testament in witness to the above have come to
set my hand this 9th day of March 1801
