

In the Name of God Amen. I Lemuel Russell of the State of North Carolina
 this Family of Connecticut, being sick and weak in body but of sound mind and
 memory thanks be to God for the day. Calling to mind the mortality of my
 Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die. do make and declare
 this my last will and Testament in manner and form following. First of all
 I Give and bequeath my Soul to almighty God that gave it me. My Body
 to be buried in a Christian like manner and as touching such worldly goods
 as I have as it hath pleased God, to bestow upon me I Give and bequeath of
 In the following manner to wit

Item I Give & bequeath unto my son Willis Russell the South part of
 My Land and Plantation. Reserving the Jacob Saroyan Land as per with
 Wards to the Ocean, the Southward of my dwelling house, & the main boundary
 a straight Line, so as to strike the western side of a ditch that comes
 from William Poy, thence with said ditch to the main road, thence Southward
 with the main road, to Wiltoughby Loughs Land, thence easterly with
 said Loughs Land, to Jacob Saroyan Land, to him and his heirs forever.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my son Lemuel Russell the remainder part
 of my Land and Plantation, to him and his heirs forever.

Item I Give the use of my negro woman, Murren unto my wife Peggy
 Russell, during her natural life, and after the death of my wife Peggy
 the said negro and her increase if any hereafter, to be equally divided
 amongst my Children. I Give unto my wife Peggy one horse, one
 pair of Oxen if there should be two at my decease, also six of my largest hogs
 also six of my smallest sized hogs, also one cow and five or six
 sheep for three years and Lamb if such at my decease, also twenty
 barrels of Corn, if there is as much at my decease, also all my farming tools.

My will and desire is that if my wife keeps my Children then of expense
 she has to have the use of my plantation until my son comes to age.
 The above I Give to my wife, to her and her heirs forever. Also I Give unto
 my wife my spinning wheels and Loom & Hay and Straw, also seven cutting
 knives for the hills, & Dutch Oven, to her and her heirs forever.

Item I Give unto my son Willis Russell one negro boy, Laddie, to him and his heirs
 forever. Item I Give and bequeath unto my daughter, Leah Russell one
 negro girl called Rachel to her and her heirs forever.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my son Lemuel Russell, one negro boy called
 Guff to him and his heirs forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Willis Russell one feather bed and
 Furniture. Only reserving the use of said bed unto my wife and my wife Peggy
 until my son comes to age, if she keeps my son. Also of expense.
 To him and his heirs forever.

201. Item my will and desire is that after paying my debts and debts charges on
 the money I have at my decease, go to the use of my family.

Item I Give and bequeath my son Lemuel Russell one feather bed and
 Furniture. Only reserving the use of said bed to my wife Peggy if she keeps
 my son then of any expense, till he comes to age, to him & his heirs forever.

Item I Give unto my daughter Leah Russell one feather bed & Furniture
 Only reserving the use of said bed to my wife Peggy if she keeps my daughter
 then of any expense till she comes to age, to her & her heirs forever.

Item I will that my two negro Dick be sold for six months and
 the money arising therefrom I Give unto my daughter Leah.

Item I Give unto my son Lemuel Russell six hives, twelve hives to him
 and his heirs. Item I Give unto my daughter Leah Russell six hives, twelve hives to her
 and her heirs.

Item I Give unto my son Willis Russell one half mill.

Item I Give unto my wife Peggy Russell two silver Basins, two Dishes and
 a Tea Cup, & a Spoon, one Tea pot, six plates, knives & forks, one water pail
 one Stock of Brass, and the remainder to be sold and the money

arising therefrom to be divided amongst my Children Willis Russell
 Lemuel Russell, my wife and desire is that all the remaining part of my estate
 should with and without debt, that I have not already given away be sold for
 six months credit, and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided among
 my Children Willis, Leah and Lemuel Russell.

Item I appoint Thomas Poyner my whole and sole executor of this my
 last will and Testament, ratifying and confirming this and so allowing to be my
 last will and Testament, Given under my hand and seal this 29th day
 of September 1806.
