In the name of God amen I Davis Ballentine being in a feeble state of health but in my perfect senses and disposing memory thank be to God for it do make constitute and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Lee one negro man by the name of Irian to her and her heirs forever I then I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Ballentine the East side of my Plantation and land where on I now live beginning at a gum near a ditch at the road running along behind the garden down to an apple tree thence a westerly course to a gum then to an other apple tree thence a Southwardly course down the middle of the Canal as far as my land runs to him and his heirs forever I then I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Ballentine the West side of my land bounding on the line of Henry Ballentine it being that part whereon he now lives to him and his heirs forever I then I will and desire that my swamp land that I bought from the Williams and my marsh and meadow be equally divided between my two sons Henry and Joseph Ballentine to them and their heirs forever I then I give and bequeath unto my two sons Henry and Joseph Ballentine my negro man Merce to be equally divided between them I then I will and desire that all the rest of my property be sold by my

Executor and after paying all my just debts all the balance of money arising from such sale to be equally divided between my three children to wit Nancy Lee Henry Ballentine and Joseph Ballentine lastly I nominate and appoint my two sons Henry Ballentine and Joseph Ballentine to be my Executors to this my last Will and Testament revoking all former will by me made in Witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 14th day of November 1819

I then I give and bequeath unto my son John W Jones the following negroes Owen Joe Rocky and her child further with all the household and kitchen furniture that he now has in possession with all stock of Cattle except one cow which my nego woman Amy now has for her use and seven or eight young bull yearlings I then I have and bequeath to Charles Morfort the following property all my lands on Knott Island Currituck County N. Carolina and houses and lots in said Borough of Norfolk with all my part of the salt works and and my vessel now building our house with all the following things David Daniel Venns & Priscilla with all my household and kitchen furniture until her present children namely Albert Galatan Jerome Bonapart Catherine Taylor Robert P Bishop and Sarah Bundry shall all arrive the age of twenty one year for their support and then to be equally divided between all of said children then living

 It is my desire that my negro woman Amy live where she now lives unmolested during her life and also that after the death of my wife Lydia Jones that the said Amy and all her children be divid amongst the above named children.
 Item It is my desire that the ballance of Estate be sold at the discretion of my Executor except my double eared gold watch which I give unto the above Robert F. Bishop forever and lastly I constitute and appoint my Cousin Moses Bonny Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking all others as witness signed and sealed this 3^d day of September 1822 and for my said Executor not to be compelled to give bond and security for the performance of the same.

The last will and Testament of Samuel Salyear Senr.
 deceased Exhibited and proved at Feb Term 1822

State of North Carolina In the name of God Amen
 Currituck County I Samuel Salyear Senr. of the State and County aforesaid being in a low State of health but of sound mind and memory thank be to God for the same. Calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit.
 Item. I give and bequeath unto my son John B Salyear the land and plantation whereon I now live with all the appurtenances therunto belonging bounded on the South on the Land of James Whitehall and on the North on the land of Samuel Salyear junr to him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever. but in case my said son should die without such heir or heirs then I give the said land and plantation to my daughter Susanna Salyear and her heirs forever. also I give and bequeath unto my son John B Salyear the piece of land I bought of Lewis Williams containing seventy one and a half acres of land to him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten of his body forever but in case my said son should die without such heir or heirs then I give the said land unto my Daughter Susanna Salyear and her heirs forever.
 Item. I give and bequeath unto my son Francis Salyear the land and plantation I bought of James Taylor to him and his heirs forever.

Also I give unto my son Francis Salyear fifty acres of swamp land out of the deed and land I bought of Samuel Jarvis lying back of the land formerly belonging to Joseph Gray deceased to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Salyear one piece of swamp land I bought of Jarvis Allen containing seventy one and a half acres to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John B Salyear the other fifty acres of Swamp Land out of the deed of Samuel Jarvis to him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever but in case my said son should die without such heir or heirs then I give said swamp land unto my daughter Susanna Salyear and her heirs forever.

6 Item. I give and bequeath unto my three sons Samuel Salyear John B Salyear and Francis Salyear all my privilege of swamp lands lying back of James Swartz and Richard Allen reference being had to the Will of Thomas Taylor deceased and the deed of James Taylor the privilege will fully appear to them and their heirs forever.

7 Item. I give and bequeath unto daughter Julia Salyear all my land lying on the east side of the main Road forming the land of Samuel Lindory and also the piece of land I bought at the Widow of Nathan Saloom deceased to her and her heirs forever. Also one piece of swamp land lying back of the land where Nathan Saloom deceased formerly lived containing one hundred and eighty acres to her and her heirs forever.

8 Item. I give and bequeath unto my three sons Samuel Salyear John B Salyear and Francis Salyear an Island called Copey Island to them and their heirs forever. Also I give unto my three sons Samuel Salyear John B Salyear and Francis Salyear all my lands an Piney Island that I bought of Thomas Simmons and William Woodhouse to them and their heirs forever.

9 Item. I give and bequeath unto my three sons Samuel Salyear John B Salyear and Francis Salyear and my two Daughters Julia Salyear and Susanna Salyear one hundred acres of swamp Land out of the my partent that lyeth back of John T. Murringtons to them and their heirs forever.

10 Item. - my will and desire is that after my decease my Executor hereafter named set at Six and Twelve months Credit all my Lands on the Banks lying at the Whales head and where Mr. William Lewis lives tog then with all my stock of all kinds on the Banks. Also the ballance of my Swamp Land not given away lying back of John T. Murringtons and the Copey swamp I bought of Robert Taylor & Mary Taylor
