Turton, and Sally Turton, All my land and Negroes to be equally divided between them six, when the youngest is of Age, as wable to law, to them and their heirs forever, And for My land to be sent out yearly, and My Negroes hired out yearly till the youngest there is arrived, to Age by law.

Item I leave, all the real of my property within doors and without, to be sold for the raising and schooling My six Children, and when they are all of Age, I Give, and bequeath, to My six above named Children, All my estate to be equally divided between them six, to them and their heirs forever, and I hereby Make and Ordain My worthy friends, Gabe Sears and Mitchell Simmons, Executors of this my last Will and Testament, in witness whereof, I the said Archelus Turton, have to this my last will and Testament, set my hand and Seal, the day and year above written,

Item I Give to My daughter Nancy Crabbe, One Shilling and No more, all the rest of my property within and without doors, My will is that it be equally divided between My three Sonneted Children, Samuel Berry John Berry, and Franky Berry, so as that my two Sons parts, are equal with my daughters parts and legacies, and if either of them die without heir of their body lawfully begotten their part to go to the survivors and their heirs, Lastly I nominate and appoint My Son Richard Berry my Executor, to this my last will, and Testament, in witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 14th day of May, 1802,
