The Last Will and Testament of Sally Hutchens deceased
 Exhibited and Proved At November Term 1825

In the name of God Amen, I Sally Hutchens of Currituck
 County & State of North Carolina being of sound mind and
 memory do this sixth day of August one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty five make and publish this my
 last Will and Testament in manner following that to wit
 First I give and bequeath all my land to be equally divided
 between Major Wright son of Owen Wright and Harry
 Lee son of William Lee to them and their heirs forever
 I give and bequeath to my sister Turner Wright my chest and
 all my wearing apparel to her and her heirs forever
 I give and bequeath to Timmy Gregory the sum of ten dollars
 I give to Tom Falford the sum ten dollars to her and her heirs
 I give to Beloy Parr daughter of Richard Parr ten dollars
 I give to Marry Gregory wife of Wm Gregory one Cow & Heavens
 After pay my debts out of what has not been given away, I give
 and bequeath the one half of the property that has not been given
 above to be equally divided between all my sister Turner
 Wright's children - I give and bequeath the other half to be equally
 divided between Wallis Hutchens Harry Hutchens and
 Amy Lee - I make and ordain my friend James Bell
 my executor to this my last will and Testament
 in witness whereof I the said Sally Hutchens hath set my
 hand and seal this day & year above written
 signed, sealed, published
 and declared in the presence of
 us, who were present.
