That is to say First I recommend my soul to Almighty God who
gave it & my body to be buried in a Christian like manner &
as touching my worldly Estate I dispose of it in manner
& form following

I Give & bequeath to my son John Humphreys one
silver bed & silver & gold furniture & art now is it being
the same as I bought at my husbands sale, one Dresser
and all in it that I have not Given away, only he is to
buy for my daughter Nancy Humphreys one set of
China of at a such a quality as the rest of the China
to him and his heirs for ever.

I Give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy Humphreys one silver
bed & bolster & pillow & furniture, one half dozen silver teaspoons,
also one set of China which my son John Humphreys is to
buy for her - to her and her heirs forever

I Give & bequeath to my daughter Lida Forbes one silver bed one pair
of sheets one set of China. Next half a dozen cups & saucers, one teapot
one milk pot & sugar dish it being the same that Pledge White brought
for me. to her & her heirs forever

Lastly I nominate & appoint my son John Humphreys Executor
to this my last will & Testament testifying this to be my last will
& Testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal this 26th day of March 1797

I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Ball one Horse
then named Mat to her and her heirs forever

I Give to my Son Samuel Olier one New riding saddle to
him and his heirs forever

I Give My Will and desire is that all my purchaseable Estate
both within doors and without shall be divided and Equally
divided between my nine Daughters to wit Mary Walker
Sarah Jones Rebecca Holliday Bridget Ball Ann Gray
Dorcas Jones Julian M'horney James Woodhouse and
Sally Eganer share and share alike to them and their heirs
forever - Lastly I leave my two sons Nathan Olier
(and Sam^l Olier my whole and sole Executors of this
my last Will and Testament. Testifying and confirming
this and no other to be my last Will & Testament in this
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this sixth day of March 1797
