 I am I Give unto my Son Anthony Simmons one
 set of books belonging to him and no more to him
 I am I Give unto my Son Jonathan Simmons one
 silver dollar and no more I am I Give unto
 daughter Sarah M. Planning one chamber bed and
 furniture, belonging thereto and one half of my wearing
 and one set of and a better, which I have already lent unto
 her I am I Give unto my daughter Polly Simmons the high
 Bed slugs and the bed and furniture belonging thereto and
 one safe and all the cooking ware and all the
 Crock ware ever belong to said safe and one
 Wheel and one spinning wheel one tea kettle one pair of
 five tongs and one half dozen tea spoons, and one half
 dozen table spoons one hatchet one shirt and one half
 dozen chairs and one Sack and her share of the
 Hens, but one of them I Give her and one Ben and
 Wattle belonging thereto the Cider is now in the house that I
 gave her the Knife box and the Knives and forks, belonging
 thereto I Give unto her I am I Give unto my son
 John Simmons one treadmill, Beer and Sticks, and furniture
 belonging thereto and one high Bedstead
 I Give unto him I Give and nothing else, and all the
 remaining Part of all my estate not given away to my
 Children in legacies I devise and will to be sold by my
 Executors and money arising from such or says Property to pay
 all my debts, and after the debts is paid the remaining
 from the sale of such Property I Give unto my daughter
 Polly Simmons. I Likewise appoint my Son William Simmons
 and my daughter Polly Simmons, Executors of this
 My last will and testament, signed sealed and delivered in
 Presence of Son a Simmons Suck.
