Item 12th it is my will & desire that all the Property I have not already given away at the death or marriage of my wife should be sold to pay my debts and the remainder to be in equal division between my three daughters say Ann Evans, Sally Evans and Malley Evans after all I nominate & appoint my wife Edney Evans Executrix to this my last will and Testament this 13th day of February 1836.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly S Etheridge one feather bed & one Linnen wheel

Item I also give to my grand daughter Polly S Etheridge one four foot chest forever

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Edney Simmons one feather bed that stands in any hall room forever

Item I give & bequeath to my son Anthony Simmons one pair of Study desks and one huckle forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Bell and grand daughter Polly S Etheridge my cart & riding chain to be equally divided between them their heirs forever

Item I give to my son Anthony Simmons one table cloth to him & his heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Bell one table cloth to her & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly S Etheridge one table cloth to her & her heirs forever

Item I leave all the residue of my property to be sold to pay my debts and expenses of my funeral and if there be any left after that to be divided between my son Anthony Simmons & Sarah Bell & Polly S Etheridge

and their heirs forever.

The Last Will & Testament of Joseph Bell
Deed proved at February Term 1831

In the name of God, Amen, I Joseph Bell of Currituck County, being in a very low state of health, but in my perfect senses and sound disposing mind, thanks be to almighty God am now fit to make, constitute and ordain this my last will & testament in manner following as follows.

Item. I leave the use of my land & plantation to my beloved wife Elizabeth Bell during her natural life and after her decease I give and bequeath the aforesaid land & plantation to Dennis Meekson of young Bell oughting West to him & his heirs forever.

I have given to my sister Sally Bell Twenty five
dollars to be raised out of my estate -

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Bell all the remainder of my property after paying my just debts to her and her heirs forever - lastly I nominate and appoint my trusty friend Jonah Goff
