Item 15th it is my will & desire that all the Property I have not already given away at the death or marriage of my wife it should be sold & pay my debts and the remainder to be an equal division between my three daughters Mary Ann Owens Sally Evans and Melly Evans after all I nominate appoint my wife Edney Evans Executor to this my last will and Testament this 13th day of February 1834.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Edney Simmons one feather bed that stands in my hall room forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Anthony Simmons one pair of study aids and one hackle forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Pell and grand daughter Polly D. Ethridge my cart & riding chain to be equally divided between and their heirs forever.

Item I give to my son Anthony Simmons one table cloth to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Pell one table cloth to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly D. Ethridge one table cloth to her & her heirs forever.

Item I leave all the residue of my property to be sold to pay my debts and expenses of my funeral and if there be any left after that to be divided between my son Anthony Simmons & Sarah Pell & Polly D. Ethridge.

Item I give to my sister Sally Bell Twenty five dollars to be raised out of my estate - Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Bell all the remainder of my property after paying my just debts to her and her heirs forever - Lastly I nominate and appoint my trusty friend Jonah Joliff
