Item I give and bequeath unto my son Stephen Westcott two negro boys by
The name of Paulen and Isaac. to him and his heirs forever. and one
Brass Kettle also I give and bequeath unto him my son Stephen Westcott
The plantation colourd I have since after my decease to him & his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Westcott one piece of
Tract of Land adjoining my manner plantation on the east side of
Roan Oak Island containing one hundred acres of more or less. to him and
His heirs forever also I give unto him two negro boys by the name of Annis
and Aaron. to him and his heirs forever and one feather bed and furniture.
Item I give and bequeath unto my son Asa Westcott two negro
Boys named Will and Primmi. to him and his heirs forever. and one feather
Bed and furniture also I give unto him one piece of Land on Parish of
Land joining Barnabes Thridges Land to him and his heirs forever. and
One feather bed and furniture the land to contain twenty acres more or less
Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Bethany Westcott one half
of Little Cottingham Island and one half of the stock thereon and one
Negro Gal named Hannah and one feather bed and furniture to her
and her heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Westcott one half
of Little Cottingham Island and one half of the stock thereon and one
Negro woman by the name of Charity and one negro boy named Job
Only it is my will and desire that all the increase that Springs from
The negro Charity hereafter shall be divided equally divided betwixt my
Two daughters Elizabeth and Bethany to them and their heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath unto my two Grand Sons Zachariah Gibbs and
Stephen Gibbs one piece of Land lying on the east side of Roan Oak
Island containing fifty acres more or less to them and their heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Winiford Thridges one negro
Boy Jack to her and her heirs forever
