Item I give unto my son Henry Fanshawe the land whereon I now live to him and his heirs forever, known by the name of Pitts Lodge, beginning at James Jones corner of oak then to a white oak then to an Elm at the turn.

Item I give unto my son, Moses Fanshawe my old plantation & all the Remainder part of my land to him and his heirs forever,

Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Wife Grace Fanshawe all the Remainder part of my Estate both within & without Doors - During her Widowhood or her natural Life And then to my son Charles Fanshawe and Daughter Franky Fanshawe.

Item I do appoint my well beloved Wife Grace Fanshawe and my trusty friend William Simmons to be my whole and sole Executors & Executrix of this my last will and Testament in that whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixing my Seal this 27th Day of March 1798

As Touching & Disposing of all such Temporal Estate as I have I please God to bestow upon me I give & dispose thereof followeth. First I will that all my Debt be paid & discharged

Item I give to my beloved Daughter Lydia one Iron bed & Cover
Three pewter plates One pewter basin One Iron kettle one bible
One Scales One pine Chest

Item I give to my beloved Daughter Franky one high bed & Cover
Three pewter plates One dish One small dish One hair comb
One Stone One Cedar Chest One small pot one pail one basin

Item I give to Henry Evans one bed and furniture as in Bill of Sale one Iron bed
One hair comb one basin one small dish one bowl one plate one basin
One hair comb one Iron kettle

Item I give to well beloved wife Nancy Brattle the use of the place
whereon I now live during her life or Widowhood then to my Daughter
Chloe Brattle y^e she should die without heir to my Daughter

Item I give to my Daughter Chloe Brattle the bed & furniture I now use
Use of one flat high one pewter basin one pewter plate one hair comb

Item I give to my beloved Wife Nancy Brattle one mare & all her
Tools & Mill and Horse and cart & all the
same with and contents of I leave my beloved wife Nancy Brattle and
other friend Egan Miller full and sole Executors of this my last will & Testament
