of the Schooner William Gray may be sold and if Nicholas Daniel
this is bound to buy to be here and to pay at right hundred dollars giving
Notes with good Security at Twelve months Credit, otherwise to be
sold at public Sale for said Credit, my Children or houses I intend to
be sold for six months Credit, excepting one more and one more, all
Which I Give to my son, then if there increase also I Give my
free negroes by the name of Hannah and Randolph and increase to
my son Norris Daniel also my share I Give to my son
Also the material part of my household furniture, excepting in Chest and
One bed and furniture I leave to be sold for six months Credit, and the
Chest and bed and furniture that I reserved I give to my son Norris
Daniel and my desire is that the whole of the money that the above bills
are to be collected, and kept for my said son without paying out on
Interest also my desire is that my land and house may be sold for
said Norris Daniel and not to be written out.

I appoint my father William Daniel Senr. my trustee and executor
And to take my son Norris Daniel and to take care of him and his
Property this being my last will and Testament witness my hand and
Seal this 2^d day of June. 1806. Nicholas Daniel

sound mind and memory knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make &
Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following
I Give the use of all my estate within doors and without to my beloved wife
Elizabeth Gregory during her natural life, or widowhood provided she keep my
Children together, and ease them Clear of any Charge, or expense to them at her
Marriage or death. Said estate to be divided equally amongst all my Children
I Give my desire is that my executor hereafter named, sell as much of my estate real
and personal as shall be sufficient to pay all my debts, and in Case there is not
Enough of my Property to pay the debts &c. so that a part of my said must be
sold I desire that my said executor, sell the whole of my lands together and
the remainder to be equally divided between my wife and all my Children
Lastly I nominate and appoint my friend Samuel Horner executor of my whole
and sole executor to this my last will and Testament &c. in witness
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal, this 29th day of August
