

The Last Will and Testament of Peter Parker deceased -
 State of South Carolina. In the name of God amen
 Cumberland County. I Peter Parker of the State of
 County of said, being in good health & sound mind and
 memory, thanks be to God for the same, calling to mind
 the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed
 for all men to die, do make and ordain this my last
 Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit
 I send the use of my land, I have deeded to Mason W.
 Parker & Peter Parker as per their agreement by bond
 as therein stated unto my wife Fanny Parker during
 her life or widowhood. I send also unto the use & benefit
 of my wife Fanny Parker unto my wife Fanny
 during her life or widowhood, also my horses cart and
 riding chair & harness together with all my household &
 kitchen furniture during her life or widowhood. I also
 send the use of one half of my stock viz Cattle, Sheep &
 Hogs to my wife Fanny during her life or widowhood,
 and also all the money in full consideration of my years
 provision. I also send my two thirds of the salt bats
 at Partridge's Mill for her use & benefit during her life
 or widowhood -

I send I give unto my son Joseph Parker deceased, heirs namely John
 Fanny, Joseph, Patrick & Nancy Parker - one eighth part of my
 beach or land lying at Partridge's Mill to them & their heirs forever.
 I send I give unto my two Grand sons namely William Holloway
 and Peter Holloway sons of John Holloway one eighth part
 of my beach land lying at Partridge's Mill to them & their
 heirs forever
 I send I give unto my daughter Lydia Williams wife of Robert
 S. Williams, unto my son Mason W. Parker, unto my
 daughter Fanny Dancy wife of Sampson Dancy, unto my daughter
 Elizabeth Parker, unto my son Peter Parker and unto my
 daughter Betsey Williams wife of John Williams the three
 six eights of my beach land lying at Partridge's Mill
 to be equally divided among them & their heirs forever

I send. After the death or widowhood of my wife Fanny I give
 unto my daughter Betsey Williams one feather bed and furniture
 the third choice to her and her heirs forever

I send. After the death or widowhood of my wife Fanny I give
 unto my two grandsons Joseph Parker & Patrick Parker one
 feather bed and furniture the fourth choice to them and their heirs forever

I send the property remaining after my death not given away
 I give to be equally divided between my daughters Lydia
 Williams, Fanny Dancy, Elizabeth Parker & Betsey Williams
 to them & their heirs forever.

I send the property left unto my wife Fanny during her life
 or widowhood. After her death or widowhood I give the said
 property unto my four daughters viz Lydia Williams, Fanny
 Dancy, Elizabeth Parker & Betsey Williams to be equally
 divided among them & their heirs forever
 I send Lastly I do nominate and appoint my son John in
 Law my Robert S. Williams, Sampson Dancy & John Williams
 executors to this my last Will and Testament, revoking
 all other will or wills by me made Ratifying and
 confirming this to be my last Will and Testament -
