And the remaining part of my property to be Equally divided between all the Rest of my Children after the death or marriage of my Beloved wife Polly Taylor except my son Thomas Taylor to them and their heirs for ever. I will so constitute and ordain my beloved wife Polly Taylor my whole and sole Executor. I will so Rescind and declare this to be my Last will and Testament this 13 day of October 1810 In witness whereof I set my hand and seal

I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Lee the Remainder of my Estate both with in down and without of my National and kind for her to raise my Children on to her and her heirs for ever. Resolving and dis-annulling all other wills and gifts. Ratifying and confirm- ing this to be my last will and testament. I do nominate and appoint my friend John Williams whole and sole Executor of this my Last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of July one Thousand Eight hundred and Ten
