

In the Name of God Amen I Randal Jones last of the County of Currituck in the State of N^o Carolina Planter being weak in body but of a sound & Perfect mind and Memory as my body is free from pain thanks be to God Almighty for the same therefore Calling to mind the uncertainty of life & certainty of Death & Knowing that it is appointed for all human Once to Die and after Death to appear in Judgment therefore Recommend my Soul to Almighty God that gave it me and my body to be Buried in such Christian Like Manner as shall be to the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Mentioned and as for my Worldly Estate Where with it has Pleased Almighty God to Bless me with I bestow in the following manner in Proportion

I Give and bequeath unto Joseph Jones the Land & plantations Whence I know Live Beginning on this Sound Side in That Jarvis Line with S. Jarvis Line Westerly - Thence with Taylors Line to the Swamp Southerly to Jose Taylors Line Thence Easterly to the Main Road Thence Southerly to Randal Jones first Line Thence Easterly with his Line to the Sound Thence Northerly to the first Station to Include the Whole of the Tract as Described to him and his heirs & assigns for Ever Item I Give & bequeath unto the heirs of my Daughter Darkis Dowdall Now De^d one Shilling - Starting to them & their heirs for Ever

Item I Give & Bequeath to Daughter Rebecca Gibson Wife to John Gibson one Shilling Starting to her and her heirs for Ever

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Joseph & Mary Jones my Daughter all the Residue of my Estate that I have Not heretofore Given away both Within Doors & without to be Equally Divided Between them to them & their heirs forever I Likewise Constitute make and order my Son Joseph Jones Executor of this my Last Will and Testament & Do hereby Disannul Revoke all and Every other former Testamentary Will or Wills heretofore made by me in any Wise Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my Last Will and Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and first my Seal this second Day of July 1798

In the Name of God Amen I Joseph Jones last of the County of Currituck and State of North Carolina being in a weak State of health but of a sound mind and disposing memory thanks be to Almighty God for it and by this Do Publish Proclaim and Declare that this is and shall be my Last Will and Testament in Writing

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Beloved Wife Catron Jones all my Land to have and to hold During her Widow hood then to be Equally Divided Between my two Daughters Elizabeth & Patsy Jones to them and their heirs of their Bodies for Ever Item I Give and bequeath also unto my Beloved Wife Catron Jones one Mare & one horse worth forty Dollars that I sold the young horse for and likewise all her Part of Barroth Estate that was coming to me when I Married her Item I Give and Bequeath unto

Randolph Jones one Cow for the use of my child Patsy Jones or as long as he keeps the child or the cow lives

then who ever keeps my child is to take the cow for the use of my child till and all the increase of the said cow is to go with my child for her use Item I Give unto

my wife Catron Jones three Beds and two bedsteads two Blankets and one Rug During her widow hood then to be Equally Divided Between my two Daughters

Elizabeth and Patsy Jones also to my wife three Chairs During her widow hood also two Windsor Chairs to my wife all the rest of my Estate Equally to be Divided

Between my two Daughters Patsy and Elizabeth Jones I Likewise make Constitute and Order my Wife Catron Jones Executor of this my Last Will and Testament and

I Do hereby Disannul all and Every other Will that I have made or may make by me Joseph Jones Do Order this to be my last Will & Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Eleventh Day of September 1798 Signed sealed and Delivered in the Presence of us
