

In the Name of God Amen I Rebecca Claland in the County of Currituck & State of North Carolina being in sound & perfect Memory thanks be to God for the same, do make & ordain that I do be my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made to confirm this to be my last Will and Testament in manner & form following Viz. I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it & my body I give to the earth from whence it was taken to be buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter named my worldly Goods I give as follows. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved sister Catherine Lurvey the worth of her of my Negro girl Abby during her natural life & then to her Daughter Eunulope Lurvey to her & her heirs forever but in case her Daughter Eunulope die without issue of her body lawfully begotten in that case it is my desire that my Negro Abby should be sold & the Money to be equally divided between all my sister Catherine Lurvey's Children which shall be at that time living Item I give & bequeath unto my sister Deborah Taylor my double Paricle & Clothe to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give unto Mary & her two Children Nathaniel & Rebecca Presbly ten Pounds for the Use & Content of schooling them, also give to Nancy & her two Children George & Pethery & her two ten Pounds for the Use of schooling them. Item I give and bequeath unto sister Deborah Taylor and Golly & her two Children all my Wearing apparel with the Remainder part of my Estate which shall appear or given away to them & their heirs for ever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my sister Elizabeth Lurvey Twenty Shillings in full of all her portion - Item I give & bequeath unto sister Catherine Lurvey my Negro Girl Abby all the Balance of a Note against George Baith for Estate after the above mentioned Twenty Pounds is paid to schooling the four Children of Mary & her two Children as above mentioned & I do also appoint Brother William Lurvey my friend Caleb Church to be my Executor to the my last Will & Testament as Witness my hand and seal this 28 day of January in year of our Lord 1798

In the Name of God Amen I Mathias Ethridge of the County of Currituck and State of North Carolina being in perfect health of body & sound sense of both Mind & Memory blessed be God for it do make & ordain and constitute this to be my last Will & Testament in Manner and form following that is to say

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Edy Ethridge all my Personal Estate both within and without during her Natural Life or Widowhood and then at her death to be Equally divided between my Daughter Edy Ethridge and my grand son Mathias Ethridge to them and their heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Ethridge the sum of five Shillings Sterling Money to be paid to her out of my Estate it being all the part of my Estate in full that I have her to her & her heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Edy Ethridge all the land and Plantation whereon I now live but if she should die without a lawfull heir then the said land to return to my grand son Mathias Ethridge and if he should die without an heir lawfully begotten of his body then the said land to return to my Daughter Sarah Ethridge to her and her heirs for ever

Item my will and desire is that my grand son Mathias Ethridge shall make a firm right and Title to his part of my son Emily Ethridges Widow Mary Ethridges Estate that she refused before my son Emily married her if he should refuse upon request when he comes to the years of Maturity then his part of my Estate to return to her

Item my will and desire is that my Daughter Edy Ethridge shall pay my grand son Mathias Ethridge the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money of North Carolina if she should refuse to pay when he comes to the years of Maturity then for him to Enjoy one half of my land to him and his heirs for ever. Lastly I Nominate and appoint my beloved Wife Edy Ethridge whole and sole Executor to the my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have signed and seal this 30 day of July 1795
