 his Debts to be disposed of in manner following, first he
 desired that three barrels of Corn might be bought and
 given to his Wife Sarah Walker and the Remainder to
 be equally Divided between his 2 Wife & his two Children
 Peter & Sarah Walker and desired that Thomas Walker
 should sell his Estate the above was proved & subscribed by
 the Witnesses before us this 23rd day of February 1793
 and the Will was Examined if they had any Objection
 to be sealed the had none.
