 ing house, one Kitchen, one house During her Widowhood, and
 I give to my said Wife Mary four Cattle her first Choice, and
 twenty hogs her first Choice, also one Negro Woman named Lucy
 and one Bed Furniture her first Choice, and all the shining White
 Working & Linen and one Loom & and the Truckling belonging to it
 the best Cattle, and the best Table, and two of the best Chairs and
 the best Bed & paying down Kase & a pair of Legs Irons, and a pair
 of Irons Irons, and a Looking Glass, and one half of the Butter, one
 half of the Tubbs Paile & Piggins to her and her heirs forever.
 Also my Will and Desire is that my said Wife Mary should have
 the Use of my Negro Man named Sam during her Widowhood
 and also one Parcel During her Widowhood, and the Cattle belong
 to her, and I give to my said Wife Mary four Cattle
 I give and bequeath unto my two Sons Joseph Ballentine
 and Lewis Ballentine the Lands and Plantations whereon I
 now live to be equally Divided between them only my son Joseph
 to his first Choice, to them and their heirs forever.
 I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Ballentine all
 the Lands thought of Hanover & also my daughter Julia and his
 heirs forever.

Also I give to my son Henry and Negro Boy named Sam to
 him & his heirs forever.
 I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lydia, I bequeath
 all the Property which I thought of at the time of the Property of
 John Bennett which was Cattle located to the Publick, to her and
 her heirs forever, and also one Negro Girl named Phoebe
 to her & her heirs forever.
 I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Euphan Bennett
 one Negro Girl named Chole to her and her heirs forever.
 I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Knight one
 Negro Girl named Mary to her and her heirs forever.
 I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Ballen one
 one Negro Girl named Phoebe to her and her heirs forever.
 I give to my said Daughter Lucy Ballen one half
 of a Negro Man named Pegg to her and her heirs forever.
 I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Ballen one
 one Negro Girl named Phoebe to her and her heirs forever.
 I give one half of the Negro Woman Pegg to her and her heirs
 forever.
 I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Julia Ballen one
 one Negro Man named Tom to her and her heirs forever
 and also one Negro Girl named Dinah and one bed and
 Joiner the second best and my Riding Chair & Harness &
 Dress and the Linen belonging to it to her and her heirs forever.
 I give to my two Sons Joseph & Lewis the Negro called Sam
 after my Wife's Marriage or Death to them and their heirs forever.
 Also my Will and Desire is that the Gift to my two Sons
 Joseph & Lewis should include all my Lands pertaining to them
 where I now live on to them & their heirs forever.
 I also constitute and appoint my son Joseph & my friend Samuel
 Williams my whole and sole Executors to this my last Will and Testam
 ent, to see all my Estate settled according to this my last Will and
 Testament shall require of themselves my hand and seal this 10th
