hereafter Named, I do give and bequeath all my just Debts to be paid by my Executors
then I Give and bequeath this Parcel of land situate and known unto me by
Land and Survey by a straight line beginning at the bound line to be through
the Middle of a low Ground or Swamp to with a straight line to Daniel Rogers at
Corner tree with all the Land to the Richard of P. line, to him and his heirs forever.
I Give and bequeath to my beloved Son Thomas Odom, all that part of my
Land called the Cold Settlement to the Eastward of my then I amle's line to Dan
Rogers forever, Hence a straight line across my Land to William Chubb's line
to him and his heirs forever.
I Give and bequeath all my best Land to my Son Nathl Odom to him
and his heirs forever.
My desire is if either of my Sons should die that is to say Daniel
Odom or Thomas Odom without issue Lawfully begot of their body or then the
them and their heirs forever.
I Give and bequeath one fourth part and parcel to my beloved Daughter
Elizabeth Odom and a fourth to my beloved Daughter Eiza both Odom one fourth
part and parcel to her and her heirs forever.

The Last Will and Testament of Joseph Robert
In the Name of God Amen, The Twenty first day
January Seventeen hundred and Ninety three
of the County of Guilford and State of North Carolina being dead
in Body but Sound and Perfect Mind & Memory and lastly of sound
the uncertainty of Life & knowing that it is appointed for all Men
Once to Die I make Ordain Constitute & appoint this to be my
Last Will and Testament (I) I Will my Soul to Almighty
God who gave it & my Body to be Buried & buried at the Discretion
of my Friends and Executors and as to the thing my worldly estate
whereunto I hath Pleased God to Bless me with in this life
after killing and paying my Debts
I Give all my Property both real and Personal within and
Without to my beloved Wife Rachel during her whole
Life I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Rachel me than
of my Moveable Property within and without
I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Betsy the other two
thirds of my Moveable Property within & Without
I Give and bequeath to my son William all my Land and
Tenements to him and his heirs of his body forever and of his wife
Without her of his Body I Give it to Betsy and her heirs of her
Body forever and if they both Die without heirs of their Bodies
I Give the whole of the above explained Property to my beloved Wife
and her heirs forever I my beloved Wife Rachel & thought I Will
and my Executors should think it prudent for her to Possess and use
the above said Property during the Term of Years and from the
above date let it be done. Lastly I do hereby Ordain and
Appoint my beloved Wife Rachel Greber John Perkins Joseph
Ballentine to be my sole & sole Executors of this my last Will and
Testament as Witness whereunto I have set my hand and seal
my Seal Signed sealed and delivered Robert Greber and
