 Alms and money thanks be given to almighty God I have
 Mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men once to
 die I have this again this my last will and Testament be it so

 into the hands of almighty God that gave it into my body I commit
 the earth to be buried in such Christian burial as the doctors of
 Divinity, nothing doubting, but the General Resurrection, I shall receive
 the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching
 such worldly estate as herewith I hath blessed God to bless me
 this life I give divers and diverse of the same in the following
 manner. I give first I give to my wife Elizabeth Mearns
 and last. whom I now live with the house & improved
 household goods debts movable during her widowhood or life thing after
 her death, the house and land with dog bed and furniture I give to
 my daughter Hester Mearns also I give to my son William Mearns
 fifty acres of land joining Christopher Mearns's land running from the
 road to the sea also I give to my son Archibald Mearns
 fifty acres of land joining Elizabeth Mearns's running from the beach
 to the sea. Likewise I give to my daughter Elizabeth Mearns fifty
 acres of land between the new fence lying between Christopher Mearns
 and William Mearns. Likewise I give to my daughter Sarah Mearns
 fifty acres of land. Likewise the new line joining Archibald Mearns
 to the sea. Likewise I give to my daughter Emily Mearns
 fifty acres of land joining my daughter Elizabeth Mearns on the
 one side and all the remainder part of my land and movable at my wife's
 death I give to all my sons and daughters to be equally divided among
 them all. Likewise I bequeath unto Gordon Mearns Elizabeth Mearns
 my wife & William Mearns my son. Executor of this my last
 will & Testament. If I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul
 all and every other former Testament, wills, legacies, bequestes, and
 bequests by me in any before. made writs & bequestes touching my
 Real Estate. I confirm this above to be my last will and Testament. In
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty seven
 of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 signed sealed & delivered Published pronounced and
 attested by the said Robert Mearns as his last will
 and Testament in the presence of us who in his
 presence and in the presence of each other
 have hereunto subscribed our names.
