

The last Will & Testament of Robert Heath stands thus &c.

In the Name of God Amen I Robert Heath of the County of Middlesex and Province of North Carolina being sick and weak in Body and Calling to mind that it is appointed for all once to dy Do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner as followeth

Item I Give and bequeath to my son William Heath the Plantation and Land that I have been on and that Land that Elizabeth Heath now lives on the tract containing two hundred acres to him and his heirs for ever not for him to have the Liberty of selling it till he comes to the years of thirty one and one half mill and my Heirs

Item I Give and bequeath to my son Robert Heath fifty acres of Land lying in the Precinct of the North West Corner of the S. Market and fifty acres in a place called Bear pen Ridge to him and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to my son James Heath one hundred acres of Land being part of the Precinct of the North West Corner of the S. Market and one half mill and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Heath fifty acres of Land & Place called the Dedded Ground to her and her heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Heath one half mill and one fifth part of the Precinct of the North West Corner of the S. Market and one half mill and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Heath one half mill and one fifth part of the Precinct of the North West Corner of the S. Market and one half mill and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter with all the Rest of my Estate that I am not able to give after my Death to be equally paid out of it both for present and future use I appoint my wife my Heirs and Heirs of my Body my last will and Testament Respecting all other things of which I am not able to dispose by this my last will and Testament being the last day of my life and
