 during his natural life I give to his son Thomas Payne, I give to
 to my son John Payne one Negro boy by the name of James and
 my Grand son Thomas Payne comes to the age of eighteen years I
 give to be given up to the said Thomas Payne, I give
 to my son James Payne one Negro girl by the name of Mary
 until his daughter Nancy comes to the age of fifteen years I
 give to be given up to said Nancy. I give to my son
 James Payne one horse by name Peter James Jones his bridle.
 I give to my son John Payne one horse called by name
 Buck of dark mane saddle, bridle. I give to my Grand daughter
 Lelia Payne one young mare by the name of William also.
 One Saddle bridle. I give my will I desire is
 that all my Estate of every kind be equally divided between my two
 sons. that I have not already given away of all my movable
 property both within doors & without, & every kind be equally divided
 between my two sons except one linen white gown & one
 cloak. I give to my Grand daughter Lelia Payne.
 I desire my will I desire is that Andrew Duke James Payne
 of John Payne be my Executor to this my last will &
 Testament in writing which I have hereunto set my hand
 & seal this 25th Day of July 1802 Robert Payne Seal

 I give and bequeath to my son John Stewart all the
 Remainder of my property within doors and without after paying
 all my last debts and funeral expenses to him and his heirs forever.
 Lastly I nominate and appoint my Trusty friend Saml. Parker
 Executor of my whole and Sole Executor to my last will and
 Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
