I give to my wife two feather beds, and three cows and colves, ten head of hogs, one horse and chair and cart, one spinning wheel six sitting chairs & one loom, three pots and Dutch oven, one blade chest, all of the droughill stock, all the earthen ware, the money that is now due, I give to my wife to finish the buildings with and give hick of shelp, one pair of flat irons, stays and gears.

Item. I give to my daughter Amey bason a new nut totat, and one feather bed and spinning wheel. It is my desire that all that is not given away to be sold in doors and out doors, and the money to be equally divided among my three children, and it is my desire that they should have their parts of money at eighteen years of age, ratifying and confirming this to be my last will and testament. I also appoint my dear beloved wife and friend David Mould whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament, this the second of February eighteen hundred & thirty three

First I give to my son Peter Parr, two red cows and their increase, also one gun, hog and lands after my wife decessed, also to my son David Parr one ewe after my wife decessed, also I give to my son Jesse Parr, one ewe after my wife Themy Parr decessed, also I give to my daughter Mary White one ewe after my wife decessed, all the rest of my property I give to my wife Themy Parr during her natural life

after my wife Themy Parr decessed. I leave all my property to be sold and equal divided among my four children. David Parr Jesse Parr and Mary White and Peter Parr: also if one of my child, dear dies for, the property to belong to my three children, and if the other dies, to belong to the other two children, and ~~the other~~ after the others dies to belong to the other one child. Also I leave my wife Themy Parr, whole and sole executrix, hereunto I have set my hand and seal this 3^d of Oct 1811

I Robert West, of the state of North Carolina and county of Currituck, being weak and imperfect in body, hath but of sound memory, but for the good will and affection, which I do bear towards my dear beloved wife, which is to say this being my last will and testament, first I do give and bequeath unto my wife Sally West the land whereon I do live, during of her life, and after her decess, the same I do give unto my sister's son George Dough, and also I desire the land whereon my mother do live after her decess I desire to be rented out untill Charles Dough arrives at age, and the rent to be equally divided amongst all of brothers and sisters, and I do give the said land whereon my mother do now live, to Charles Dough, to be his at arven to age, and give William Chodoe the land that I possess at the road and I do give unto my beloved wife one negro man by the name of Isaac, and give unto my one horse and one riding chair, and after my just debt being paid, I do give and bequeath unto my wife Sally West the remainder of my of my estate both in doors and without this given the 7th 1813.
