Item I give and bequeath to my granddaughter Sarah Thindge One Young heifer

Item I give and bequeath to my grandson Caleb Thindge my horn birds and water
to him and his heirs forever, and my Chest, that I bought of W^m Holloway

And one Young steer—

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand son Caleb Thindge the money that is due to me by
Note from Amos Thindge—

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand son Caleb Thindge One Cow and calf—

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand son Caleb Thindge all my Airts and things
of mine to him and his heirs forever—

My Will and desire is that William Lee have one Gourd & one Coat

Grannah Harding have all the rest of my clothes—

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Diniah Miller One Young heifer

And I do Nominate and appoint my son Caleb Thindge to be my Executor

of this my last Will and Testament in Testimony Whereof I have hereunto

of my Estate within and without during her life, & after her decease to be Equally divided
Amongst all my Children Mary Thindge, Caleb Thindge, Wm^r Thindge, Lydia Thindge
Abigail Beaton, & Samuel Thindge to them and their heirs forever—

I do hereby Nominate and appoint my well beloved Wife Mary Thindge, Son
Caleb Thindge, my Wife and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament
