I give to my Daughter Asah Land one cow and 1 heifer

And all the rest of my Estate I give to my wife Mary Land during
her life & after her death Equally divided among my 3 children and I
desire make full power and Mary shall my heirs & my children
my last will & Testament of all and singular the Land and
movables of my Estate as witness my hand & seal y^e day & year
above written signed sealed and delivered by me

Manuel Gray being weak of body past of death's disposing manner
calling to mind the uncertainty of human life so that it is appointed
one poor man to die to make it clear this my last will & Testament
in manner and form following

Impremis I give & bequeath to my son Stephen Gray one tract of land con-
taining one hundred acres known by the name of Grays joining on
y^e Lines of Willis Upster James White to him my said son & the
heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever also one negro child
named Suckie & one negro fellow named Adam to my said son Stephen
Gray this heirs as absolute forever

I give & bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Gray one negro woman named
Sarah to her & her heirs lawfully begotten of her body forever also
one negro woman named Tegg to her & her heirs as aforesaid for ever
knowing the use of the said Sarah to my dear daughter Nancy
Bridget Gray during her natural life as also I do hereby reserve the
use of all the other negroes to my wife as aforesaid & to the use of my child
Stephen & Nancy Gray come to age and if the the negroes Suckie &
Tegg have offspring when my children come to age to be equally divided
between them so to be continued so divided to them & their heirs
as aforesaid forever

Item I give & bequeath to my wife as aforesaid one mare named Lighten
Stone horse named Jacob forever And Reserving my modest pro-
visions wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me both with in-
doors & without as bees & stock as cattle, Horses, Hogs, Swine &c &c
after my last debts is paid, I will & bequeath the use of them to my
wife Bridget Gray during her natural lifetime and then to be
Equally divided between my two children as aforesaid Stephen
& Nancy Gray & their heirs lawfully begotten forever Lastly
I will desire that my wife Bridget Gray & Thomas Taylor her
husband be and are hereby appointed the sole Executors to this my
last will & Testament given under my hand & seal this 5th day
of July 1843
