The Last Will and Testament of Samuel Robinson deceased exhibited & proved at August term 1824

I Samuel Robinson of the County of Prince Ann and State of Virginia, being weak of body, but of sound and perfect mind and memory, before be almighty God for the same; do make and publish this my last Will and Testament of testimony in manner and form following to w^tch I do give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary all my property the goods and chattels except one small Bed and bedstead and one small wheel which I do give and bequeath to my niece Anna; forever. The residue of all my personal estate, goods and chattels I give and bequeath the same to my said beloved wife Mary Whom I hereby appoint sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. In virtue whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three

The Last Will and Testament of Joseph Jimmons deceased
Exhibited & proved at August Term 1824

In the name of God amen. I Joseph Jimmons being in health in body, but of sound and perfect mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life and that it is appointed for man to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that to say

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Julia Jimmons one negro Girl named Dice to her and her heirs forever also one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Julia Jimmons one negro girl by the name of Lenny to her and her husband

Item I bind all the use of my property within doors and without to my beloved wife Ann Jimmons during her natural life or widowhood if she considers that is more property than she needs she can sell it on her acct

Item I give and bequeath to my four sons John Jimmons, Monroe Jimmons, Samuel Jimmons and Patrick Jimmons all my land to be equally divided to them and their heirs forever

Item I leave all the property that I leave to my beloved wife Ann Jimmons after death or marriage to be equally divided among all my children except Roselle Jimmons and Lucy Jimmons as I have given them their portion before by Deed and dont intend them to have any more of my property

Last my will and desire is that my beloved wife Ann Jimmons should be and she is hereby appointed and ordained the whole and sole executor to this my last will and testament in witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 30th day of June in the year of our Lord 1824
