The last Will and Testament of Leonard Leachman of
Jacob Leachfield and William Nickerson late of the County of
was in and lawfully executed, proved and the said will executed
(except the house & Executors) Lawfully in due form of Law
The said Will was ordered to be recorded and stands here
recorded as follows to wit: —

You the Consistory
 Council at Hartford. In the name of God Amen, I Samuel Saunders of the County
 and Province of New York being Sick and Weak of body of a sound Disposition mind
 and Memory thanks be to God for the same calling to mind the Title Appointed for
 will shew to His Majesty and Ordain this my last Will and testament
 in manner and form as followeth, That namely, amongst of all I Give
 and Recommend my Soul to Almighty God that gave it and
 nothing doubting, but to receive in and through the merits of my
 Redeemer Jesus Christ of God for all my sins, Teaching
 these Worldly Goods where with it hath Pleased God to Bless
 me with. I Give and bequeath in the following Manner.

expressing Myself and my wife to my Dear and loving Wife Mary -
Saunders our four Negroes (viz) one Fellow Named Daniel,
one Boy Named Peter one Negro woman Named Ginny -
and one Daughter Named Rachel takes Give to my Wife three feather
Beds and the furniture to them belonging for Myself my Son
(that live with me) (use them) one Horse Named Folly and
one Collie Dog (and) ten Cows and Calves, five of which out
of the Stock that belongs at home, the other five out of the
Stock at the Banks (and) eight Head of Sheep.

In 1791, Moses and bequeathed to my Son Thomas Sugrassen and to his
 Heirs Lawfully begotten forever the Land and Plantations which
 Henry Gipsen now lives (which Land was given by Col.^d John
 Woodhouse to his daughter Mary, who the Plantations and
 Land bought of Richard Barret, and the Land and Plantations
 Simon Willison M^{ch}el formerly lived joining the Land bought
 of Barret, also given by Son Thomas M^{ch}el Negroes Nov^r

and to the Heirs of this Body Lawfully Begotten for ever
my Land Plantations and Towns in Right the Name
of the God of the Bay, Excepting this before to be shown

Aradan Mitchel now lives on on by the name of
Barfield Point, which I give to be to him to be
and to the heirs of Mrs. Bridget Laidly, Bridget and
in case he dies without issue, to be to the heirs that
now I give the said land unto my son Samuel and his
heirs as aforesaid. i. Also give and bequeath unto my son

hires as a s^r? i^o Also gave and Bequeathed to my son
Samuel Swendsen & to his Heirs & Lawfully Begotten heirs
The Plantation wherein I now live and all the Land and the
belonging thereto from the Land of the Big to my brother Joseph
Also gave my said son three Negroes (M^o) one boy named
Jackson &c. Named Jackson next. Named somewhere between
Bradwitha Striped Tick, horn span and blue legs & Fremont
one Mohogony Deek some Mohogony Gas to J^r Brown.

I presume I shall say too soon Thomas and Samuel have become
acquainted some way - however I feel especially pleased
between them as they think Boker is one of their own
I will give to my poor sons each all the remainder of my stock for life
and those that I have not already given away to be equally divided
between them.

I leave all the Remainder Part of my Estate that I have
 not already Given away, to be equally Divided between my
 Loving Wife Mary Sanderson, and my Two Sons Thomas
 & Samuel Sanderson. my Will and Desires

That Joseph Saunderson Senr. Should have all my wearing
Apparill.

Do constitute my Dear and Loving Wife and ones
Father Thomas Alexander my whole sole Ex^{or}
and Executor of this my last Will and Testament -

Dismissing all others in Testimony whereof I have
 hereunto set my Hand and affixed my Seal this 23rd
 Day of Jan^y in the year of our Lord Anno Domini 1775.

 now calling to mind the uncertainty of this Life &
 knowing that I am appointed for it Men once to die
 and after I shall be judged by God I give and bequeath
 my Soul to God with good and easy Body to the Dust
 from whence it came to be Revived at the Pleasure of
 my Creator hereafter appointed a widow for my Wife
 Elizabeth Litchfield of both Parties I have God to be for me with I give
 and bequeath as follows to the

First my Wife and bequeath unto my Cousin Peter Litchfield
 one half of my Land and how to him and his heirs forever.
 Item I give and bequeath to my Cousin Robert Litchfield Jun^r the other
 half of my Land and how to be Equally Divided Between the
 my Cousin the Land and how to him and his heirs forever.
 And if either of these shall Die without heirs my Will

Further is that it should go to my Cousin William Hen-
 son and John Henson to him forever.

Item I give to my Dear friends Abraham Litchfield & El-
 eah Litchfield John Henson & David Gibson what moveable
 Estate I have to be Equally Divided Between them
 I have also given my Cousin Brother Peter Litchfield
 one half of this my Last Will and Testament published
 & pronounced by me the said Jacob Litchfield to be my
 Last Will and Testament this 3rd Day of December 1774
