I do and publish pronounced and delivered this to
be my last will and Testament that 19th day of
February in the year of our Lord 1795 —

God for it aye known that it is appointed for man to die
I do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
first commanding my soul to Almighty God who gave
it me and my body to be Buried at the Discretion of
my Executors hereafter mentioned also as to my Estate which it
has been please God to bless me with I dispose of in manner
following first commanding that all my just debts be
punctually paid after the Tombinder I give and bequeath
in the following Manner. I promise I send to my
beloved wife Lydia Jarves during her Natural life the one
half of the Land and Plantation and Buildings wherein
I now live and the westward part of my Plantation is
the Southward of the Creek which divides this wherein I now
live and that to be divided agreeable as the fence now stands
runs a croft the said Plantation with the privilege of
fall Timber and fire wood for the support of the same
and also two Negros by Name George and Sue and one more
called Dentor & one Riding Chair and hornet and likewise
the one fourth part of all my personal property of every
kind except my Negros whether In doors or out doors
During her Natural life as aforesaid

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Susanna Robison
her choice of my Mairs on the banks to her and her heirs
Item I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Jarves the
Land and plantation wherein I now live bounded as follows
beginning at the northerly corner of said Land then run-
ning a west course to Jonathan Lindseys line then
a southwardly with said line to a corner tree in the low
ground then a southwardly and eastwardly course
along Lindseys & Simmons line to the head of the Horse
Bridge
