 beloved wife Sarah Williams one Bed and furniture her first chamber there
 one and above and nine head of hoggs. Some Barrells of Beer. one horse
 one linn and the furniture to it and one Table one Case of knives and
 one linn and the furniture to it and one Table one Case of knives and
 one linn and half my plates and thirty three flag cloths. and one Dutch
 pot to her and heirs Item I Give and bequeath to my son
 William Williams all my land and marsh where his home is built to
 him and his heirs of his body in Virginia the land I bought of John
 White the land he bought of William Bonney. and formerly belonged to
 To Jonathan Bonney all the land and marsh to it more or less and
 If my son William Williams should die without a lawful heir of his body
 then it is my will that my son Edward Williams should have the land
 and if they should both die with such heirs then it is my will that my daughter
 Mary Williams should have the land. and I Give to my son William
 one negro man by the name of Jack. in the same manner that I Give my
 wife and I Give half my lands and marsh to my son William Williams
 in the same manner that I Give the other Item I Give and bequeath to
 my son Edward Williams the land that I now live on the land marsh
 that my father formerly owned. and the land I bought of Peter Bonney
 being it more or less to him and his heirs of his body and if my son
 Edward Williams should die without a lawful heir of his body then it is my
 will that my son William Williams should have the land and if they
 should both die without heirs of their body then it is my will that my
 daughter Sophia Williams to have my land the and heirs and I Give by
 Bequeath to my son Edward Williams to him and his heirs of his body one
 negro man named James. negro boy named Stephen. one negro boy named
 John. one negro woman named Sarah. with all his increase to him and
