

Nancy Ashbee the land and plantation wherein I now live together with the household furniture, which I am at this time possessed with also all the negroes which I have at this time in my possession, and all my stock of horses, cattle, hogs &c for the use and benefit of educating and raising my children to have them taught reading, writing and Arithmetic, as far as the rule of three, provided they are able and willing to take it, during her natural life or widowhood, and other death or marriage. I give the land and plantation wherein I now live to my son Solomon Ashbee to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Ashbee, all my lands lying to the southward and eastward of the plantation whereon I now live in Roanoke Island. I also give to my son Joseph Ashbee fifty acres of land lying on Croatan known by the name of Spruce point to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever. I give my will and devise is that if either of my two sons Joseph or Solomon should die without his lawfully begotten of their body that the land of the deceased should descend to the surviving brother to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever.

I give the land that came by my wife lying joining Adam Ethridge and Maurice Baum here living, I give and bequeath to my five daughters to wit, Polly Ashbee, Ann Baum, Fanny Ashbee, Sally Ashbee and Winiford Ashbee to be equally divided share and share alike to them and their heirs lawfully begotten of their body forever; but if either of my daughters should die without heirs as aforesaid, that part should be equally divided among the surviving parties to them and their heirs forever. I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Ashbee one negro girl by the name of Viola, two cows and calves, one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs lawfully begotten forever.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Baum one negro girl by the name of Sime, two cows and calves and one bed and furniture, which she hath now in possession to her and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Ashbee one negro boy by the name of Jack, two cows and calves, and one feather bed and furniture, to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever.

I also give unto my son Joseph Ashbee after my wife's decease, two thirds of the schooner Winiford, and the other third to my son Solomon Ashbee to him and

their heirs forever and if either party dies without issue lawfully begotten as aforesaid, that the surviving party, to have the whole with every thing thereunto belonging. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally Ashbee one negro girl by the name of Moll, two cows and calves, and one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body forever. I give and bequeath to my daughter Winiford Ashbee one negro boy by the name of Jack, two cows and calves, and one feather bed and furniture, to her and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Solomon Ashbee one negro boy by the name of London, two cows and calves, and one feather bed and furniture, to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever. I give all the rest and residue of my estate both of what nature soe kind it may, which hath not been already given away in legacies. I leave to be equally divided among all my children after my wife's decease, together with one negro man by the name of Moses now outlying which if ever caught I leave to be sold to the highest bidder, but the money which therefore to be converted to the use of my children.

Lastly, I nominate and appoint my wife Nancy Ashbee, and my daughter Polly Ashbee Executrix and my Son in law, Maurice Baum executor to this my last will and Testament, In testimony of which the said Solomon Ashbee hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this second day of October in the year of our Lord 1801.

I give and bequeath to son Joshua West one dollar, and my

daughter Sarah Hill the property that I have already left or give her, and to her, heirs if any by her body forever, and if no heirs or heirs of her body, the said property to be equally divided among Solomon Wallis' heirs. And my daughter Courtney Wallis, I give and bequeath one dollar to her, forever. And as for all the rest of property to be apportioned and divided into three parts, and one third of the said property after divided to Sarah Hill as aforesaid mentioned if any heirs of her body, and if not to Solomon Wallis' heirs to be equally divided as before mentioned and as for the other two thirds of my property which is all I give and bequeath to the heirs of Courtney & Solomon Wallis' however, and none of it to be sold, but keep for said heirs till they come to age or said Solomon Wallis dies, which is as soon I am dead my whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament, and also as guardian to take care of the said property till said heirs come to age, or needs as aforesaid mentioned. Rig the 19th of October 1809. —

Item. I give and bequeath unto my son John Waterfield Hally, the land and house wherein he lives, also one feather bed and its furniture, and all the other household furniture, and kitchen furniture, that is at the said place, and the one half of all my stock of cattle, and every other kind of stock, to him and his heirs forever. Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Polly Hally, the negro woman named Frankey, one feather bed and its furniture, which is now in her possession, and every thing she now has in possession, such as household furniture, and the one half of all my stock of cattle.

I received Diring of the county of
Carrituck and State of North Carolina, being Diring of body full of
sound disposing mind and memory, blessed by the Almighty God for
it, calling to mind the uncertainty of this life, and it being
ordained for all people to die, I do make and ordain this instrument of writing to contain my last will and testament, disannulling
all other wills and testaments heretofore made by me, either by
word or writing and this only to be taken as my last will and
testament. First, that is to say I recommend my soul to
Almighty God, that gave it and my body to be buried decently
in a Christian like manner, in a place where it shall please my
executors here after named, and also what worldly estate it hath been
pleased God to bestow me for above my debts, I give and
dispose of in manner and form as following, First, my will &
desire is that all my just debts and funeral charges should
be paid in convenient time, after my decease. Item, I give
unto my brother Azariah Diring ten dollars. —
Item, I gave unto my beloved wife Diring all the remainder
part of my estate, houses, lands, horses, cattle, sheep, hogs, goats,
any schooner boat, household furniture and all my property to
her & her heirs forever. I also constitute and appoint my
