

In the Name of the Lord Amen I being sick and weak in body, but of perfect Memory and Calling to mind the mortality of the body knowing it is One Certain Term for me to die I do hereby Contract and Ordain to my last will and Testament in Manner and form as followeth that is to say first of all I Commend my soul into the hands of the Almighty God who first gave it me secondly I desire that all my just debts should be paid by my executor, hereafter named and my heirs lawfully I leave in the Groins thirdly I desire and do hereby Give and bequeath to my daughter Sidney Perkins five shillings Out of my estate fourthly I Give and bequeath to my beloved son Jacob Gallup five shillings of my estate fifthly I Give and bequeath to my beloved son Jacob Gallup five shillings of my estate sixthly I Give and bequeath to my beloved son Stephen Gallup five shillings of my estate seventhly I Give and bequeath to my beloved Child that my wife is now with Child both five shillings eighthly I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Gallup my land and all my property within doors and without after my lawful debts be paid and my Children be payed Out And I do hereby Contract and Ordain my wife Mary Gallup my whole executor of this my last will and Testament in writing I desire to set my hand this 11th day of March 1802.

Item I leave all the residue of my estate to be paid and the amount thereof to my son Nelson Gregory to be kept at Interest for his benefit to him and his heirs forever. Lastly I do nominate and appoint Joseph Gregory executor to this my last will and Testament and I do hereby Call all others to witness all of mine in writing signed and sealed by my hand and affixed my Seal this 11th day of April Anno Domini 1802

Being sick of body but of sound disposing Mind and Memory having Calls to that it less Affluence One for all must die I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it And recommending my worldly Goods my wife and deires for all my just debts to be paid Item I Give and bequeath to my three sons Callie Forbes Tracy Forbes and William Forbes all my land to be equally divided between them and if either of them should die Without lawful heir begetter of their body for the land to go to the surviving brother to him and their heirs forever.

Item I Give to my beloved wife Mary Forbes the plantation whereon I live during her widowhood and if my wife should marry then to have only one third of the plantation also I leave One Negro woman Callie Prussar during her widowhood also I Give as much of my farming tools as Ruchary for farming also One Mare Callie Nance, also One Saddle also One loom and harness also One Cow and Calf also One sow and pig also four other hogs, two ewes and One lamb, One wooden tub One Linen ditto, Four stool Chairs two flag bottoms One pewter dish One earthen dish half a dozen Bowls and saucers One Chest One Case of knives and forks half a dozen Plates Half a dozen spoons One looking glass.

Item I Give to my daughter Lydia Evans One Negro boy Callie Samson one feather bed Now in her possession also One Cow and Calf two sheep half a dozen Plates One dish half a Case of knives and forks One Chest two Chairs One linen tub to her and her heirs forever.

Item I Give to my daughter Cortney Forbes One feather bed and furniture One Chest two ewes One Cow and Calf One Linen tub half a dozen Plates One dish half a Case of knives and forks two Chairs to her and her heirs forever.

Item I Give to my daughter Samson Forbes One bed and furniture One Cow and Calf two ewes One stone Post, also ten dollars to her and her heirs forever.

I also Give to my two daughters Cortney Forbes and Samson Forbes the Negro woman Callie Prussar and in case to be equally divided between them if either of my two daughters Cortney Forbes Samson Forbes should die Without lawful issue of their body then their part of Negro woman and in case to go to the surviving sister my William deire is that all my property Out doors and in doors shall not be divided Given away be equally divided between all my children I also appoint Luke Forbes my executor of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my Seal this 20th day of May 1802.
