I give and bequeath to my beloved son Stephen Glegg five Shillings of my Estate
Also I give and bequeath to my beloved Child that my wife is now with Child
both five Shillings. & they all give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Glegg
My last and all my property within doors and without after my lawful debts
so says and my Childrens legacy taken out And I do hereby Command and Ordain
my wife Mary Glegg My whole execution of this my last will and
testament in writing I subscribe set my hand this 11th day of April 1802.

Carolina being sick of body but of sound mind and memory and knowing it is an appointment for
all to die do make this my last will and Testament in manner as followeth. No
Compromises. I give unto my son Wilson Gregory One Negroe Girl Called Miriam to him and his
Heirs forever. Item I leave all the residue of my Estate to be sold and the amount
therefrom I give unto my son Wilson Gregory to be kept at Amherst for his benefit
to him and his heirs forever.

Item I nominate and appoint for the Gregory executors to this my last will and
Testament working and managing all affairs in writing whereof I have written.
In my hand and affixed my seal this 11^d day of April anno Domini 1802

Currituck County Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and two
Being sick of body but of sound disposing mind and memory having called to that end
Appointed Currituck for executors to die I command my soul to almighty God who gave it
And directing my worldly goods my wife and dower for all my just debts to be paid
Item I give and bequeath to my three sons Caleb Forbes, Lucy Forbes and William
Forbes all my lands to be equally divided between them and if either of them should die
Without leaving heir begotten of their body for the land to go to the surviving brother
to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give to my beloved wife Mary Forbes the plantation wherein I live during
Her widowhood and if my wife should marry then to have only one third of the
plantation also I give one Negroe woman Called Priscilla during her widowhood also I give as
much of my farming tools as necessary for farming also one Mare Called Nancy also live
Sheep there also one Cow and Calf also one sow and pigs
And four other hogs. two ewes and one lamb. one wooden Chest one Tuner Ditto,
Four foot Chairs two flag bottoms one Pewter dish one earthen dish half a dozen
Bowls and saucers one Chest one Case of knives and forks half a dozen Plates
Half a dozen Spoons one looking glass.

Item I give to my daughter Lydia Evans one Negroe boy Called Sampson one feather
Bed. Now in her possession also one Cow and Calf two Sheep half a dozen Plates
One glass half a Case of knives and forks one Chest two Chairs one Tuner which
To her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Courtney Forbes one feather bed and furniture one Chest and
Covers one Cyo and Calf one Tuner which half a dozen plates one ash half
A case of knives and forks two Chairs to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Sammire Forbes one bed and furniture one Cow and
Calf two Covers one stone Pott. also ten dollars to her and her heirs forever.

Also give to my two daughters Courtney Forbes and Sammire Forbes the Negroe woman
Called Priscilla does increase to be equally divided between them if either of my two
Daughters Courtney Forbes Sammire Forbes should die without lawful issue of their
Body then their part of Negro and so increase to go to the surviving sister May
Wilson desire is that all my property Out doors and in doors that has already
Given away be equally divided between all my Children I also appoint Luke Forbes
to write my Gregory's full inventory to this my last will and Testament In
writing before Gregory to be executed to this my last will and Testament this 21^d
day of May 1802.
